GETTING STARTED

Activate the Baby to start from newborn

After removing the baby doll from the packaging, put the dummy in her mouth, then remove to activate from the newborn mode.





BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Open the hook and loop opening on the doll's back.
- 2. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 2 new AA (AM-3/LR6)
 batteries following the diagram inside
 the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 5. Replace the battery cover and secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.



Disposal of batteries and product



The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.





PRODUCT FEATURES

1. VOLUME/ OFF SWITCH



Slide the **Volume/Off Switch** to the required volume level to turn the unit on or adjust the volume.

2. TALK WITH ME BUTTON



Press the **Talk with Me Button** and baby will invite you to talk to her. When you say something she will imitate what you said!

3. READING BUTTON



Press the **Reading Button** to choose from 3 vocabulary books to read with your baby. Read aloud to baby, listen to baby read to you or teach baby to read!

4. CARING BUTTON



Press the **Caring Button** to love and care for your baby by responding to her requests.

5. MUSIC BUTTON



Press the **Music Button** to listen to baby coo and sing-along to nursery rhymes.

6. DUMMY

Insert the **Dummy** into baby's mouth to hear cute sucking sounds.

7. BOTTLE

Insert the Bottle into baby's mouth to feed her.



8. NEWBORN BUTTON

Pressing the **Newborn Button** will reset the baby to newborn mode. The baby will forget all previous knowledge and you can experience the learning process all over again.



9. TURNING THE UNIT OFF/ AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

Slide the **Volume/Off switch** to **OFF** to turn the unit off. To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically power-off after several minutes without input.

ACTIVITIES

1. Talk with Me

Baby Talk will invite you to talk to her. When the red bow on baby's head lights-up, talk to her and she will imitate what you say!

To ensure Baby can listen clearly, please speak towards baby's front at a distance of 25cm.



You can choose from 3 vocabulary books to read with Baby. First of all she will ask you to read words to her, as she grows and learns she will encourage reading together and read the words to you.







3. CARING

Baby may get hungry or want her dummy. Respond to her requests by giving her the bottle or dummy.



4. MUSIC TIME

Baby will coo and sing along with nursery rhymes.



5. NEWBORN MODE

If you want to experience the learning process all over again, pressing the Newborn button will reset the baby to newborn mode. The baby will forget all previous knowledge.



CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
