





Unlock the packaging locks:




- ① Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- Pull out the packaging locks.

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION (Unicorn)

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the underside of the unit.
- Install 4 new "AA" size (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 4. Replace the battery cover to secure it.



BATTERY INSTALLATION (Brush)

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- 2. Locate the battery cover of the unit.
- Install 2 new "AAA" size (LR03/AM-4) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 4. Replace the battery cover to secure it.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Alkaline Batteries are recommended.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- · Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- · Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the tov.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- · Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. OFF/LOW/HIGH VOLUME SWITCH

Slide the OFF/LOW/HIGH VOLUME SWITCH to either LOW or HIGH to turn the unit ON. To turn the unit OFF, slide the switch to OFF.

2. HORN SENSOR

Use the MAKE-UP BRUSH to choose a colour from the Colour Palette and point to the HORN SENSOR to see Myla's horn and mane light up.

3. EYE SENSORS

Use the MAKE-UP BRUSH to choose a colour from the Colour Palette and point to both EYE SENSORS to see Myla's eyes light up.

4. WING SENSORS

Use the MAKE-UP BRUSH to choose a colour from the Colour Palette and point to both WING SENSORS to see Myla's wings light up.









5. LIGHT UP CHARM BUTTON

Press Myla's **LIGHT UP CHARM BUTTON** to choose different games and see the light flash.

6. MAKE-UP BRUSH & COLOUR PALETTE

Use the MAKE-UP BRUSH to choose a colour from the Colour Palette and point to Myla's horn, eyes or wings to play. In order to recognise the colour successfully, make sure the transparent part of the MAKE-UP BRUSH is pressed down and covers the selected colour on the Colour Palette completely, until the brush lights up the colour you have selected.

If the Colour Palette gets dirty, please wipe it out with a soft cloth, otherwise the colours may not be recognised successfully.

To get the best recognition, we suggest playing indoors.



Put the **MICROPHONE** close to Myla's mouth to hear her sing.


8. MOTORISED EYES AND NECK

The **EYES AND NECK** will move as Myla talks.

9. BACK SENSOR

Touch Myla's back to hear sweet phrases and see light patterns.











10. AUTOMATIC SHUT OFF

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically shut off after several minutes without input. The UNICORN can be turned on again by pressing the Light Up Charm Button; the MAKE-UP BRUSH can light up again by pressing on the colour palette to choose a colour.

When the unit repeatedly powers down, please insert new batteries and try switching it on again.

ACTIVITIES

1. MAGICAL MAKE-UP GAME

Let's learn how to do some make-up with Myla! Use the **make-up brush** to choose a colour on the **colour palette** and put it on Myla's horn, eyes or wings.

2. MAGICAL COLOUR CREATION GAME

Let's create magical colours! Use the **make-up brush** to choose a colour on the **colour palette** and put it on Myla's horn, eyes or wings. Then, use the **make-up brush** to choose another colour and put it on the same horn, eye or wing.

3. LUCKY COLOUR GAME

Touch Myla's back, she will tell you your lucky colour!

4. AMAZING MAKE-UP POWDER GAME

Use the **make-up brush** to choose a colour on my **colour palette** and apply on me. Keep applying my make-up before the light goes out!

5. LET'S ROLL GAME

Press Myla's **Light Up Charm Button** to hear her sing. When she's singing, put your hand on her Back Sensor to add some light effects to her horn, mane, eyes and wings.

6. SING WITH ME GAME

Put the **microphone** close to Myla's mouth and sing with her by turns.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.

Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries. If the problem persists, please call our Consumer Services Department on 0330 678 0149 (from UK) or +44 330 678 0149 (outside UK) and a service representative will be happy to help you.
