Removing the Packaging Locks



- ① Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- 2 Pull out and discard the packaging locks.


WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Battery Removal And Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove the old battery by pulling up on one end of the battery.
- Install 1 new AA (LR6/AM-3) battery following the diagram inside the battery box (for best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- · Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.



The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. Power / Volume Switch

Slide the switch to the **O** position to switch the unit **OFF**.

Slide it to the 1) position to turn the unit **ON** with low volume, or slide it to the 1) position to turn the unit **ON** with high volume.



2. Voice

2.1 Leg Button

Press the **Leg Button** to learn fun dinosaur facts and hear fun sounds and phrases in T-Rex mode and Armoured Up Dragon mode.



2.2 Right/Left Hand Trigger

Press the Right/Left Hand Trigger to learn fun dinosaur facts and hear fun sounds and phrases in T-Rex mode and Armoured Up Dragon mode.



2.3 Wing Button

Press the **Wing Button** to learn fun dinosaur facts and hear fun sounds and phrases in Armoured Up Dragon mode.



3. Light Up Eyes, Back and Mouth

The lights flash along with the voice and sounds.




4. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically power down after approximately 15 seconds without input. The unit can be woken up again by pressing the **Leg Button**. The unit will also automatically turn off when battery power is very low.


Note: If the unit repeatedly powers down or has abnormal responses when the unit is switched on, please install a brand new battery and try switching it on again.

HOW TO SWITCH


Switching the Race Car into Dragon Armour




1. Begin in Race Car mode.




Pull and flip one side of the car up.



3. Pull and flip the other side of the car up.



4. Flip out the car bonnet.




5. Flip the arms down.




6. Then, pull the claws out.



7. Lift up the Dragon head armour.




8. Open and fully unfold the wings.




9. The T-Rex and Dragon Armour are now ready to be combined.

Combining the T-Rex and Dragon Armour



1. Put the Dragon Armour on the T-Rex.



Overlap and lock the Dragon Armour on the T-Rex body. Make sure you hear a clicking sound. The toy is now in Armoured Up Dragon mode.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the battery when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the battery.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the battery.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new battery.
