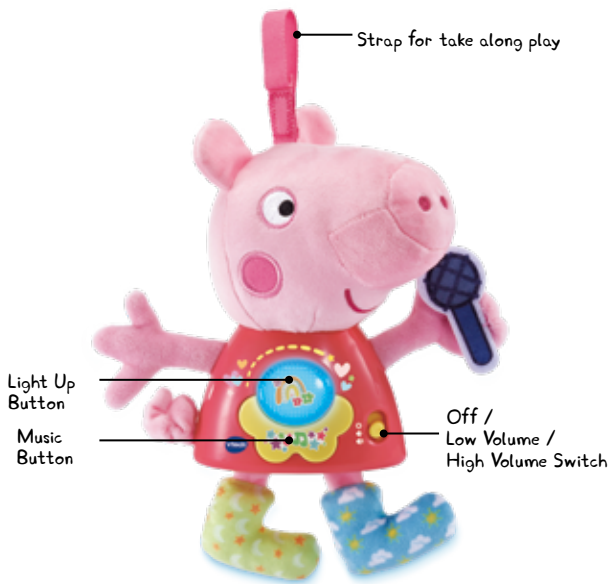

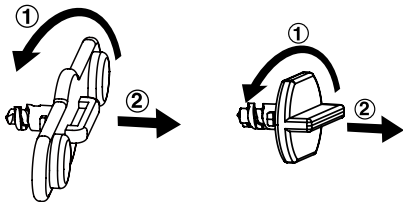

## Unlock the Packaging Locks :

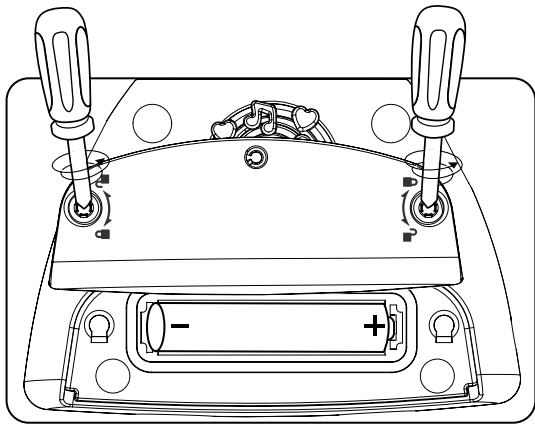


- ① Turn the packaging locks anticlockwise several times.
- ② Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

# GETTING STARTED

## BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screws and then open the battery cover.
3. If a used or spent battery is present, remove this battery from the unit by pulling up on one end of the battery.
4. Install 1 new AAA (LR03/AM-4) battery following the diagram inside the battery compartment. (For best performance, an alkaline battery is recommended. A rechargeable battery is not guaranteed to work with this product.)
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screws to secure.



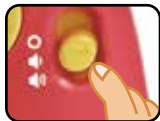
### WARNING:

# PRODUCT FEATURES

## OFF / LOW VOLUME / HIGH VOLUME SWITCH

To turn the unit **On** or adjust the volume, slide the **Off / Low Volume / High Volume Switch** to the **Low** or **High Volume** position. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **Off / Low Volume / High Volume Switch** to the **Off** position.



## LIGHT UP BUTTON

Press the **Light Up Button** to hear Peppa Pig talk with fun sounds and colourful light effects. Press the **Light Up Button** whilst songs and melodies play to jam to the music with funny sound effects.



## MUSIC BUTTON

Press the **Music Button** to hear lots of melodies and songs with Peppa.



## AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically turn off approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be woken up again by pressing the **Light Up Button** or **Music Button**.

The unit will flash with a red light three times and then automatically turn off when battery power is very low.

## **IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION**

- Insert battery with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only use batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove battery during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted battery from the toy.
- Dispose of battery safely. Do not dispose of battery in fire.

### **RECHARGEABLE BATTERY:**

- Remove rechargeable battery from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable battery is only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable battery.

## Disposal of battery and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and battery, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Battery and Accumulators Regulation.

## CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
3. Remove the battery if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
5. If the unit is not working properly, install a new battery.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Please turn the unit **OFF**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the battery.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the battery.
4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new battery.
