



Removing the packaging locks



- 1 Turn the packaging lock anticlockwise several times.
- 2 Pull out the packaging lock and discard.



- ① Rotate the packaging lock 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- 2 Pull out the packaging lock and discard.

GETTING STARTED


Battery Removal and Installation DJ Train Trax

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of **DJ Train Trax**. Then, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and remove the cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03)
 batteries following the diagram inside
 the battery box. (The use of new
 alkaline batteries is recommended for
 maximum performance).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



Mixing Table

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the green battery cover on the top of the Mixing Table. Then, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and remove the cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03)
 batteries following the diagram
 inside the battery box. (The
 use of new alkaline batteries is
 recommended for maximum performance).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metalhydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.



PRODUCT FEATURES

DJ Train Trax

1. On/Off Switch

To turn DJ Train Trax ON, slide the On/Off Switch to the ON ₺ position. To turn DJ Train Trax OFF, slide the On/Off Switch to the OFF ● position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, **DJ Train Trax** will automatically shut off after approximately 35 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **Hat Button** or pushing **DJ Train Trax** quickly.



This product is in Try Me mode in the packaging. After opening the package, turn the unit off and on again to proceed with normal play. If the unit powers down while playing, please install a new set of batteries.

Mixing Table

1. On/Off Switch

To turn the Mixing Table ON, slide the On/Off Switch to the ON Φ position. To turn the Mixing Table OFF, slide the On/Off Switch to the OFF ● position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Mixing Table** will automatically shut off after approximately 35 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by putting **Mini Cory** or **Mini Chrissy** on the **Mixing Table**, twisting the **Turntables**, turning the **Spinning Handle** or placing **DJ Train Trax** in **DJ's Parking Spot**.


This product is in Try Me mode in the packaging. After opening the package, remove Mini Cory and Mini Chrissy, place DJ Train Trax in DJ's Parking Spot or take out and reinsert the batteries to proceed with normal play. If the unit powers down while playing, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

DJ Train Trax

1. Hat Button

Press the **Hat Button** to hear fun sounds, songs, phrases and melodies. The smokestack will flash with the sounds.



2. Sounds and Melodies

Push **DJ Train Trax** to hear fun sounds. While a melody or song is playing, continue pushing **DJ Train Trax** to add in fun sounds on top of the melody or song. The smokestack will flash with the sounds.



Mixing Table

1. PlayZone Location

Place Mini Cory, Mini Chrissy or other Toot-Toot Cory Carson® mini characters on the PlayZone Location to trigger fun sounds, short tunes and phrases.



2. Spinning Handle

When Mini Cory and Mini Chrissy are on the Dancing Platforms, turn the Spinning Handle or twist the Turntables to watch them dance.Lights will flash with the sounds.



3. DJ's Parking Spot

Place **DJ Train Trax** in **DJ's Parking Spot** to press the button and trigger fun sounds and short tunes. The lights will flash with the sounds.



4. Turntables

Twist the **Turntables** on the **Dancing Platforms** back and forth to hear fun sounds, short tunes, phrases and a song. If a short tune or song is playing, twist the **Turntables** back and forth to add fun sounds on top of the music. The lights will flash with the sounds.



5. SmartPoint™ Location Place a SmartPoint™ character (sold separately) on the SmartPoint™ Location on DJ's Parking Spot to hear fun phrases and sound effects



CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
