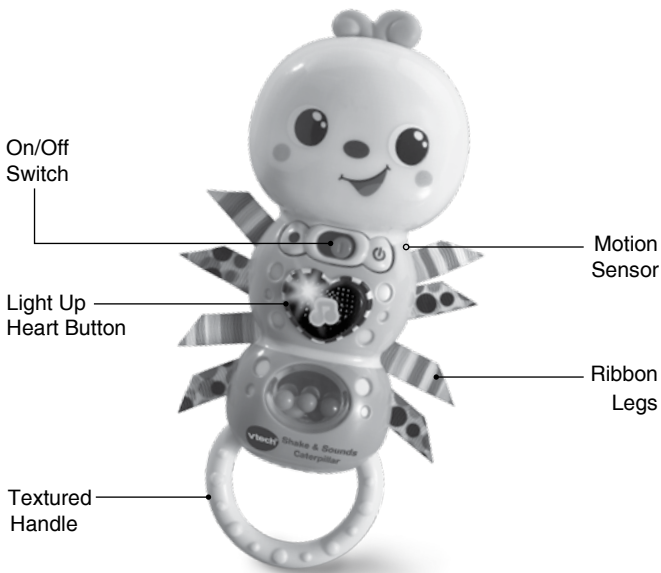

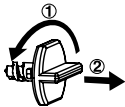

**Unlock the packaging locks:**

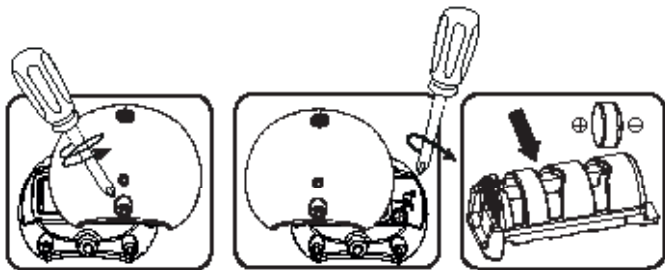


- ① Rotate the packaging lock 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- ② Pull out the packaging lock and discard.

# GETTING STARTED

## BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **off**.
2. Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. Remove the battery unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
4. Remove old button cell batteries by pushing the batteries out of the battery unit.
5. Install 3 new button cell batteries (LR44) following the diagram inside the battery unit.
6. Insert the battery unit, you will hear it click into place when inserted correctly.
7. Replace the battery cover and tighten to the screws to secure.



## **WARNING:**

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.



## **WARNING!**



Contains button battery.

- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

## RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

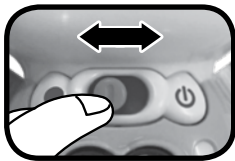

# PRODUCT FEATURES

## 1. On/Off Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **On** ☺ position. You will hear a playful caterpillar song, a phrase and sounds. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** ● position.



## 2. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Shake & Sounds Caterpillar** will automatically power down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **Light Up Heart Button**. The **Motion Sensor** will not turn the unit back on.

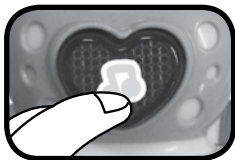
### Note:

If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing, or the light up heart button fades out, we suggest changing the batteries.

# ACTIVITIES

## 1. Light Up Heart Button

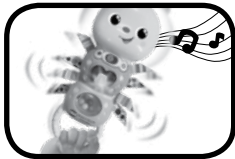
Press the **Light Up Heart Button** to hear songs, phrases, sounds and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.





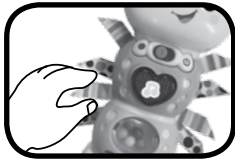
## 2. Motion Sensor

Shake the caterpillar rattle to trigger the **Motion Sensor**. You will hear sounds & phrases and see the light flash with the sounds.



## 3. Tactile Stimulation

Encourage your baby's sense of touch with the **Textured Handle** and **Ribbon Legs**.

## CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Please turn the unit **OFF**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
