



- WARNING: All packing materials such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties and packaging screws are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.
- NOTE: Please keep this parent's guide as it contains important information.

Unlock the packaging locks:

- Turn the packaging lock anticlockwise several times.
- ② Pull out and discard the packaging lock.


GETTING STARTED



The unit is in try-me mode in the packaging. Touch the **Head Sensor** to wake the unit. Then, Press the **On/Off Button** or reinsert the food item to exit try-me mode.

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- 2. Locate the battery cover and open it with a screwdriver.
- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new, alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).



- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.
- Note: If there is no response when the unit is switched on, please install new batteries and try switching it on again.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

HOW TO PLAY

1. On/Off Button



Press the On/Off Button located on the bottom of the PetSqueaks to turn the unit On. To turn the unit Off, press the button again.

Note: If the unit repeatedly powers down, please install new batteries and try switching it on again.

2. Head Sensor

Trigger the Head Sensor by petting your PetSaueaks for fun phrases, songs. sounds and motion.

3. Tummy Sensor

Tickle the Tummy Sensor to make your PetSqueaks giggle and respond with sounds, phrases and motion.

4. Bottom Sensor

Hold your **PetSqueaks** in the palm of your hand to see it stand up and respond with sounds, phrases and motion.

5. Run Button

Press the Run Button to see your PetSqueaks giggle, run and scurry away!











6. Feed Your PetSqueaks

When your **PetSqueaks** is stood up, feed it its food item by placing it between its hands. Its cheeks will light up and it will respond happily!



7. Energy Saving

To preserve energy, your **PetSqueaks** pet will automatically go to sleep after several minutes of inactivity. Your **PetSqueaks** pet can be woken up by petting its head, by pressing the **On/Off Button**, or by replacing the batteries if the existing batteries have run out of power.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to excess moisture.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit back **ON**. The unit will now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- 1. For optimal performance, please use **PetSqueaks** on a flat, smooth surface.
- 2. For your child's safety, do not put **PetSqueaks** in either configuration on your clothing, body or hair.
