WARNING:

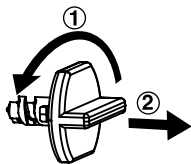
All packing materials such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties, cords and packaging screws are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE:

If there are no locks inside the package, disregard this message.

Removing the Packaging Locks:



- ① Turn the packaging locks anticlockwise several times.
- ② Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

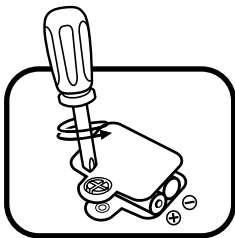

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

Dan Dog the Roadster

1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new 1.5V AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



Note:

If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing or the light fades out, we suggest changing the batteries.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product

The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

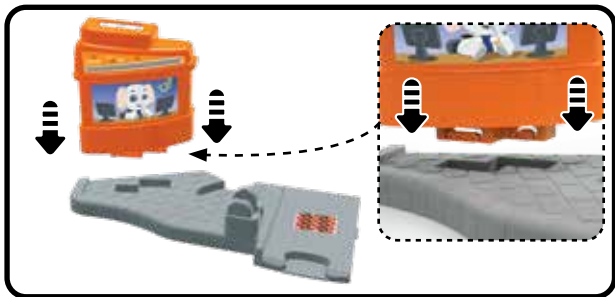
With the **Roll and Repair Garage**, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required. For your child's safety, do not let your child play with the toy until it is fully assembled.

Assemble and attach the track components following the steps as below:

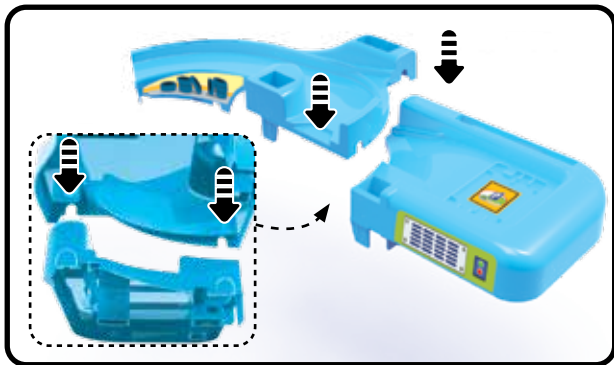
1. Insert ramp Y into ramp Z as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



2. Insert L into M as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



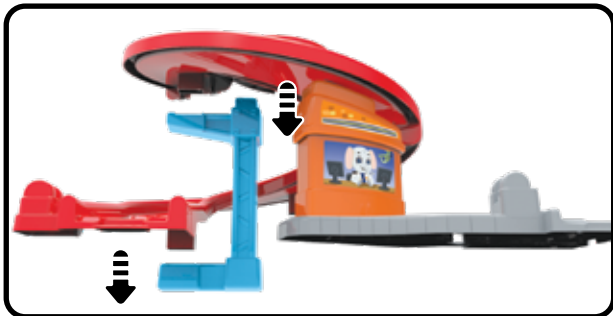
3. Connect ramp C and D (Insert ramp C into D as shown below). Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



4. Insert ramp Z into L, connect them, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



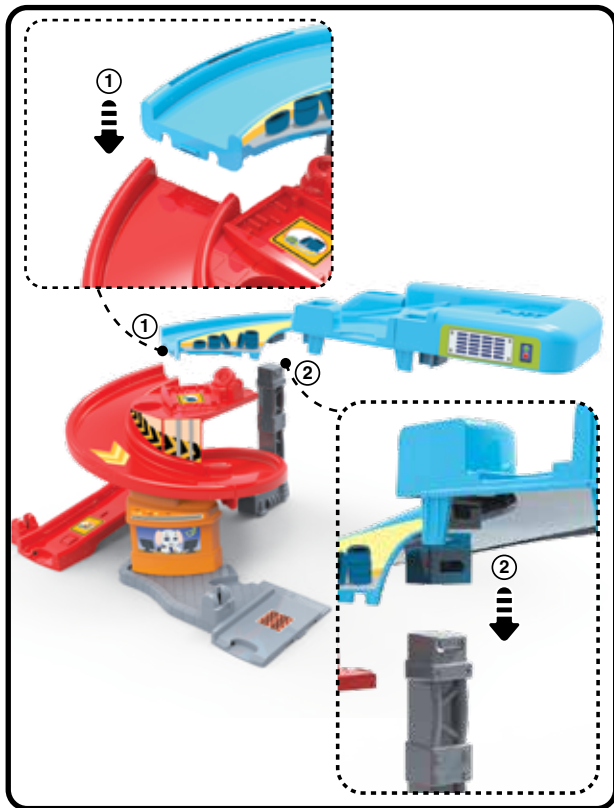
5. Insert E into ramp Y and ramp Z, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



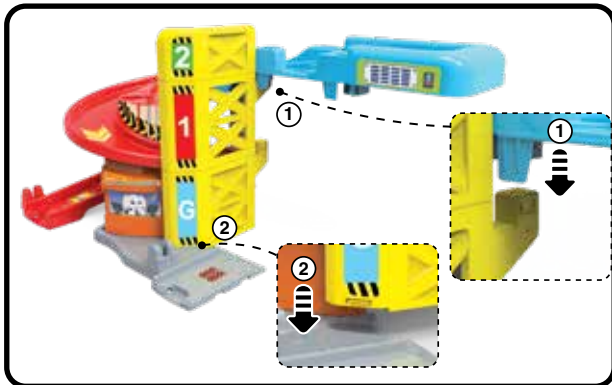
6. Insert F into ramp Y, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



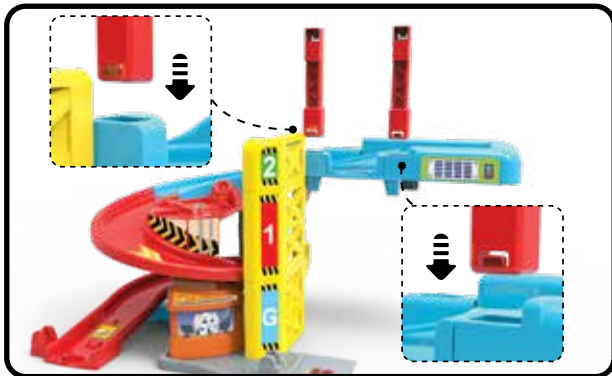
7. Connect ramp C and ramp Z (insert ramp C into ramp Z) and also insert ramp C into F, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



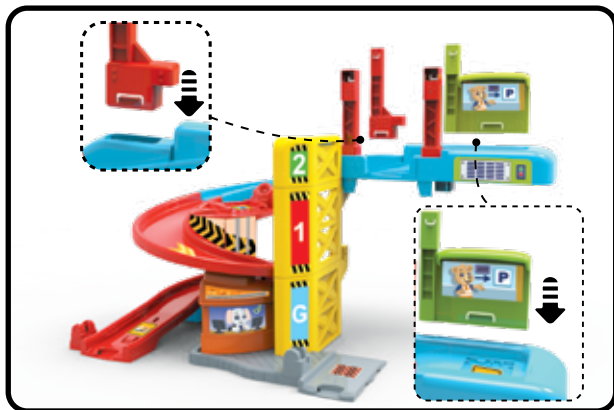
8. Insert N into M, and insert ramp C in to N, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



9. Insert one H into ramp C and one into D, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



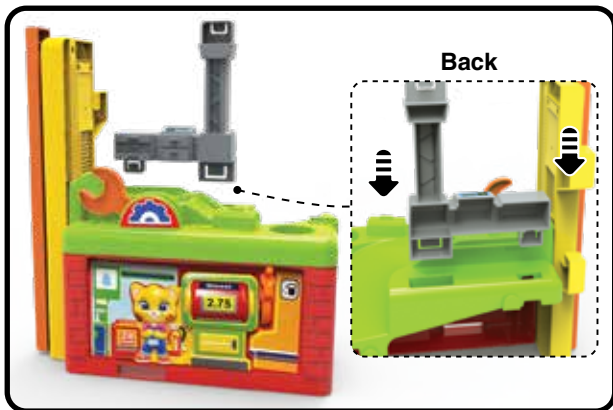
10. Insert I into ramp C and insert J into D, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



11. Insert W into X, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



12. Connect U and X (Insert U into X) and insert Q into W, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



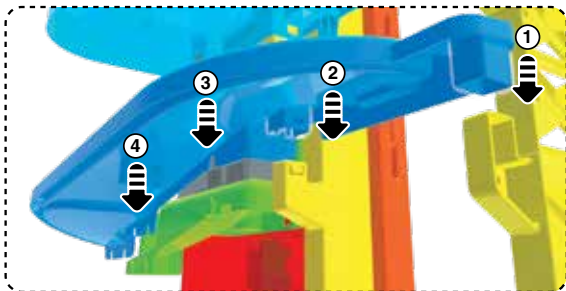
13. Insert D into U and Q, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



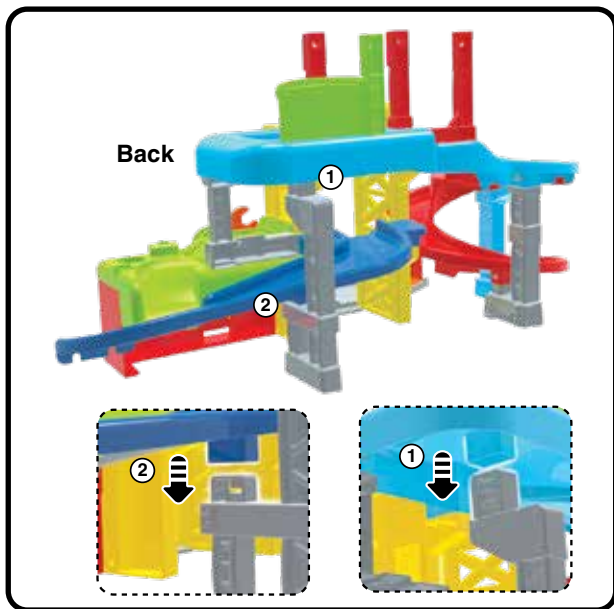
14. Insert O into N, U and W, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected. Please also note there are two grooves for W.

15. Insert G into O and D, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



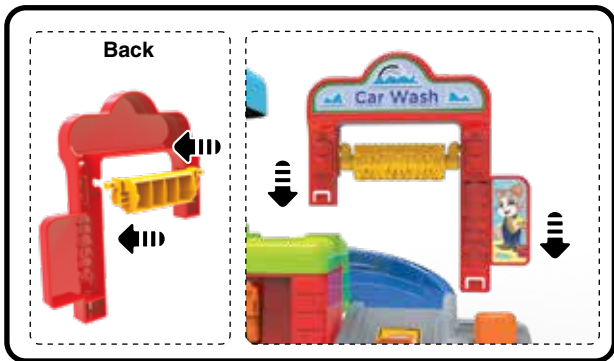
16. Connect V and O (Insert O into V, as shown below). Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



17. Connect P with V, X and M, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



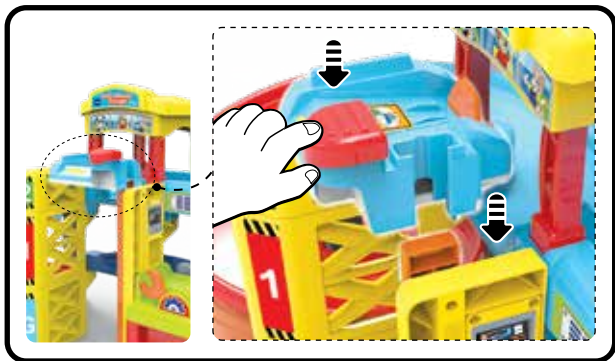
18. Insert S into the back of R, and then insert R into V and W, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



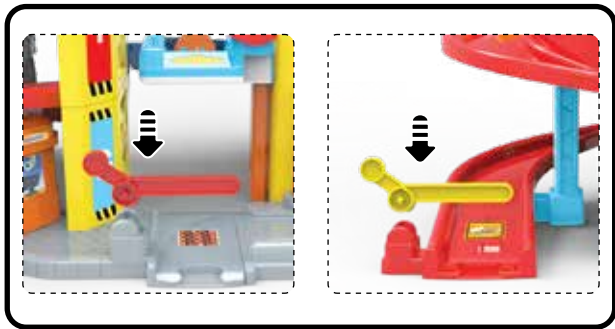
19. Insert K into the two Hs, I and J, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



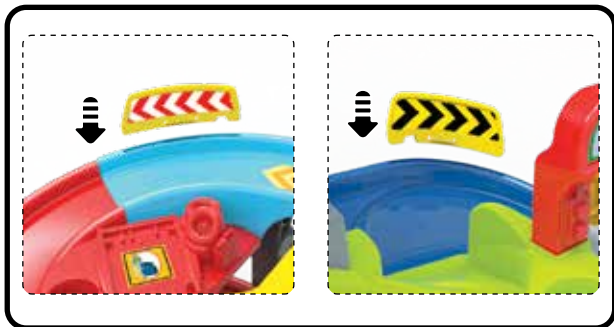
20. Press the button on T and then insert it into U, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



21. Insert the two gates in front of ramp Y and M, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



22. Insert Barrier A (the letter A can be found on the back) into ramp C and insert Barrier B (the letter B can be found on the back) into O, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



23. Insert Bear into ramp Z and insert Tiger into W, as shown below. Make sure you hear a click sound to confirm they are firmly connected.



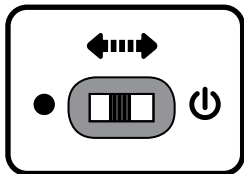
Once you've completed the above steps, you are ready to play!



PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **On** () position. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** () position.



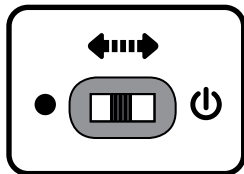
2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, **Toot-Toot Drivers® Dan Dog Roadster** will automatically power down after approximately 60 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the character button or triggering a **SmartPoint™** location.

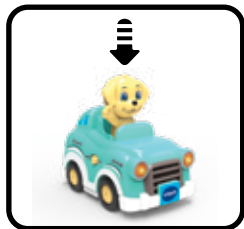
ACTIVITIES

Dan Dog Roadster

1. Slide the **On/Off Switch** to turn **Dan Dog Roadster On**. You will hear a song, phrases, and a sound. Lights will flash with the sounds.



2. Press the Character Button to hear fun sounds, songs, phrases and melodies. Lights will flash with the sounds.



3. For added fun, **Dan Dog Roadster** interacts with the Roll and Repair Garage. Simply put Dan Dog on one of the play set's seven **SmartPoint™** locations to hear fun sounds, music, phrases and see the light flash. Dan Dog also interacts with other Toot-Toot Drivers® play sets (each play set sold separately).



Roll and Repair Garage

1. Place Dan Dog or any **SmartPoint™** vehicle (each sold separately) on any of the Seven **SmartPoint™** locations to trigger fun sounds, songs or phrases.



2. Put Dan Dog on the car deck, turn the Spinner to have fun.



3. Place Dan Dog on the lift, and then press the button to raise the lift, then release and watch the car race to the bottom.



4. Place Dan Dog on the Car wash, and then push the button to release the car.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit Off.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
5. If the unit is not working properly, install a brand new set of batteries.
