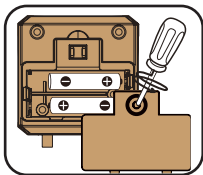
INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Module Battery Removal and Installation

1. Make sure the Module is turned Off.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the Module. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw. Then, remove the cover.
3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the Module by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AAA (LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

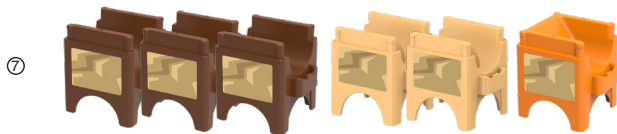
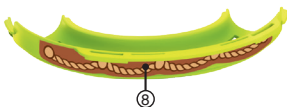
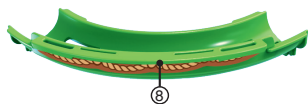
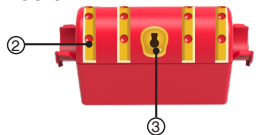
Please securely stick the labels as indicated below:

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. **OFF/Sound Switch**    
Slide the switch all the way to the right  to turn on both music and sound effects (SFX). The middle position  plays SFX with no background music for quieter play. Slide the switch all the way to the left  to turn off the unit.



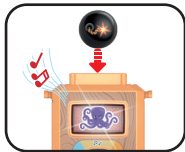
2. Music Button

Press the Music Button to cycle through the background music options. The light will flash when the button is pressed.



3. Cannon Ball Trigger

When a marble goes into the top of the Module, the light will flash and sound effects will play.



4. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Marble Rush® Adventures Pirate Ship** will automatically power-down after 90 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by sliding the **OFF/Sound Switch** to the middle or right position. If the unit powers off whilst playing, we suggest installing brand new batteries.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the battery if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit Off.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit back On. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
