

INTRODUCTION



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the electronic module inside the monkey.
 Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 3 new LR44 batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



⚠ Warning:

This product contains a button or coin cell battery. A swallowed button or coin cell battery can cause internal chemical burns in as little as two hours and lead to death. Dispose of used batteries immediately. Keep new and used batteries away from children. If you think batteries might have been swallowed or placed inside any part of the body, seek immediate medical attention.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use three LR44 alkaline button cell batteries only for this toy.
- The button cell batteries used with this product should be kept away from small children who might still put things in their mouths. If the button cell batteries are swallowed, consult a doctor immediately.
- Insert the button cell batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not use damaged button cell batteries.
- Do not short-circuit the button cell battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted button cell batteries from the product.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Control Switch

To turn the unit ON, slide the On/
Off/Volume Control Switch to the
Low Volume (◄))) or High Volume
(◄))) position. You will hear a short
tune, playful sounds, phrases and a
song. To turn the unit OFF, slide the
On/Off/Volume Control Switch to
the OFF (♠) position.



2. Banana Teether

Soft, textured teether helps soothe teething gums.



3. Apple Mirror

Baby-safe mirror is perfect for playing peek-a-boo and developing self-awareness.



4. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Swing & Sing Monkey** will automatically power down after approximately 60 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the light up heart button.

Note: The unit is in try-me mode in the gift box. Slide the On/Off/
Volume Control Switch to the off position, then turn the unit back on to activate normal play. If the unit powers down while playing, we suggest changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Heart Button

Press the **Light Up Heart Button** to hear endearing phrases and a variety of playful songs, sounds and melodies.



2. Motion Sensor

Shake the monkey to trigger the motion sensor and to hear fun sounds and phrases.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to excess moisture.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit back **ON**. The unit will now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
