


INTRODUCTION


SmartPoint[™] Mickey Train

WARNING:

All packing materials such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties and packaging screws are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE: Please keep this parent's guide as it contains important information.

WARNING:

Adult assembly required.

This package contains small screws. For your child's safety, do not let your child play with the toy until it is fully assembled.

Unlock the packaging locks:

- Turn the packaging locks anticlockwise several times.
- 2 Pull out and discard the packaging locks.



GETTING STARTED BATTERY INSTALLATION Train

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the **Train**. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).



4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure the battery cover.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metalhydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).

 Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS Mickey's Choo-Choo Express

With the VTech® Toot-Toot Drivers® Mickey's Choo-Choo Express, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

1. Insert the Ramp Support under the Ramp Track, as shown below.



2. Insert the **Gate Arm** into the **Ramp Track**, as shown below. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate the pieces are secure.



 Insert the Streetlight Sign into the Streetlight post, as shown below. Then, insert the Streetlight into the Streetlight 3/4 Straight Track, as shown below. You will hear a "click" sound to indicate the pieces are secure.






4. Insert the Gate into the Gate Straight Track, as shown below.




5. Insert Bridge Wall A and B into the Bridge Base, as shown below.



6. Insert the Flag into the Train Station, as shown below.



7. Screw the **Train Station** to the **1/4 straight track base**, as shown below.



8. After the above steps, connect these pieces to the included track pieces. You can configure them into different arrangements.



Once you've completed the above steps, you are ready to play! You can connect this play set to other **Toot-Toot Drivers**[®] play sets and tracks (sold separately).



PRODUCT FEATURES Train

1. ON/OFF SWITCH

To turn the unit **ON**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **ON** (**()**) position. To turn the unit **OFF**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **OFF** (**()**) position.




2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the **Train** will automatically power down after approximately 50 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **Character Button** or by pushing the **Train** quickly. **Note:** This product is in Try-Me mode in the packaging. After opening the package, turn the **Train** off and on again to proceed with normal play. If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing, we suggest changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES Train

- Slide the On/Off Switch to the ON position to turn the unit ON. You will hear a song, a phrase and sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.
- 2. Press the Character Button to hear fun sounds, songs and phrases. The lights will flash with the sounds.
- 3. Push the **Train** to hear fun sounds and melodies. While the melody is playing, push the vehicle again to add in fun sounds on top of the melody. The lights will flash with the sounds.







4. For added fun, the Train interacts with the Toot-Toot Drivers[®] Mickey's Choo-Choo Express. Simply roll or put the Train on one of the play set's four SmartPoint[™] locations to hear the Train play fun sounds, short tunes and phrases.


ACTIVITIES Mickey's Choo-Choo Express

 Place the Train on any of the play set's four SmartPoint[™] locations to trigger fun sounds, phrases and music.

2. Turn the hands on the Mickey Clock to hear a clicking sound.

3. Connect the Train to the Train Cart.





4. Press the hat to reveal Goofy in the popcorn booth.



 Spin the Train around the switch track and choose a direction for Mickey to go.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
