





Alfie features different textures that enhance sensory development and includes accessories for manipulative stimulation.





GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- 3. Install 2 new AA batteries following to agram inside the battery box. (The use of new, alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in Battery Directive (2006/66/EC).



PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

Locate the electronic box inside your bear. To turn the unit ON, slide the ON/ OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH to the LOW VOLUME ((()) or the HIGH VOLUME ((()) position. To turn the unit OFF, slide the ON/ OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH to the OFF (•) position.



2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the **VTech® My Friend Alfie** will automatically power-down after approximately 40 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

ACTIVITIES

1. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

Once the main power is on, press the **ON/OFF BUTTON** on Alice's clothes to turn it **ON** and **OFF**.

2. LEFT HAND/STORIES

Squeeze Alfie's left hand to learn about her hand, you will also hear a story about Alfie and his friend. Press and hold his right hand for more than one second to hear a fun phrase about reading.





3. RIGHT HAND

Squeeze Alfie's right hand to learn about her hand. Clap your hands and follow Alfie's beat. Press and hold his right hand for more than one second to hear Alfie introduce himself.

4. RIGHT FOOT/MUSIC

Squeeze Alfie's right foot to learn about his foot. You will also hear playful songs and melodies.

5. LEFT FOOT

Squeeze Alfie's left foot button to hear playful phrases about his foot and his shoe.

6. HEART

Press Alfie's heart button to hear fun phrases about the heart and Alfie's favourite clothing. Press and hold this button for more than one second to hear a loving message.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Due to the electronic components, the book is surface washable only.

- 4. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
