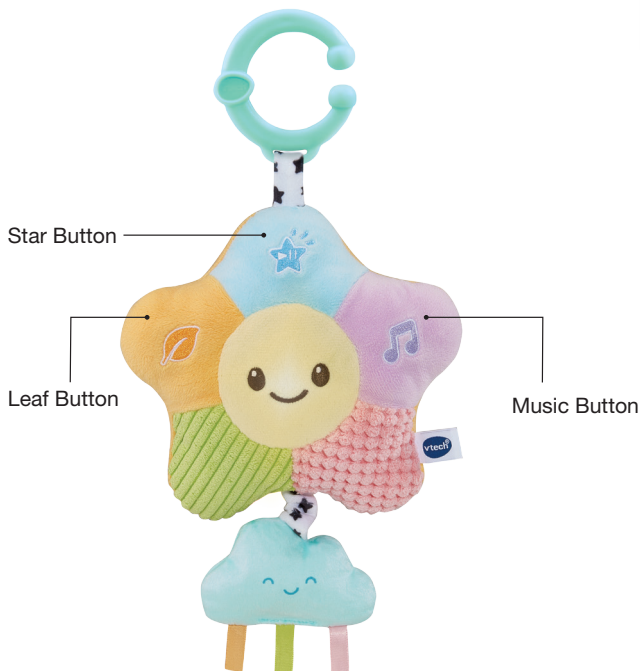

Remove product from the Infant Carrier when the vehicle is moving.

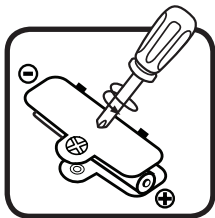
# GETTING STARTED

## WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.  
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

## Battery Removal and Installation

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Find the battery cover on the electronic module inside the star. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
3. Remove old battery by pulling up on one end of the battery.
4. Install 1 new AA battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



## NOTE

This product is in try-me mode in the packaging. To activate normal play, turn the unit **Off**, then turn the unit back **On**. If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a brand new battery.



## WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.  
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

## IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

## RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

## Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheeled bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

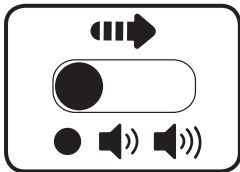

# PRODUCT FEATURES

## 1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to the **Low Volume**  or **High Volume**  position. You will hear sounds, a phrase and a song. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to the **Off**  position.



## 2. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically power down after approximately 20 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

### NOTE

If the unit powers down while playing, we suggest changing the battery.

# ACTIVITIES

## 1. Leaf Button

Press the **Leaf Button** to hear continuous nature sounds. The light will glow with the sounds.



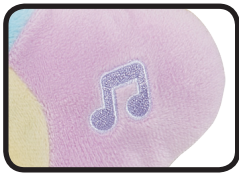
## 2. Star Button

Press the **Star Button** to pause and play the audio response.



### 3. Music Button

Press the **Music Button** to hear soothing sing-along songs and melodies. The light will glow with the sounds.

# CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the battery if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
5. If the unit stops working or malfunctions, install a brand new battery.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Please turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the battery.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the battery.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new battery.
