



GETTING STARTED

The unit is in try-me mode in the packaging. To exit try-me mode, place the car on the car carrier first, then insert the green or grey accessory part to the front of the car and turn the screw. When you hear the opening short tune, this means you have entered normal mode. If the **Off/Mode Selector** is in **OFF** position, just slide it to turn the unit on.

Battery Removal and Installation

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the unit and use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AA size (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box.
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metal-hydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in Battery Directive (2006/66/EC).

The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.







PRODUCT FEATURES

1. Off/Mode Selector

Slide the **Off/Mode Selector** to turn the unit **On** and enter Explore mode  or Challenge mode . To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **Off/Mode Selector** to the **Off**  position.




2. Road Safety Button

Press the **Road Safety Button** to learn about road safety and the colour red.



3. Car Facts Button

Press the **Car Facts Button** to learn about the colour yellow and interesting facts about the car and the car carrier.



4. Car Carrier Service Button

Press the **Car Carrier Service Button** to learn about the colour green and how a car carrier services a car.



5. Pull Handle

Use the **Pull Handle** to launch the car into the race.



6. Custom Car

Place the car on the car carrier to hear funny conversations between the vehicles and add different accessories to create and fix your unique car.




7. Push the Carrier Along

Push the car carrier along to hear melodies and fun sing-along songs.

8. Storage

Open the car carrier cab to store the accessories inside.



9. Volume Control Switch

Slide the **Volume Control Switch** on the bottom of the car carrier to adjust the volume.

10. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically shut off after several minutes without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button, putting the car back on the car carrier or sliding the **Off/Mode Selector** from one mode to the other.

Activities

1. Explore Mode

In Explore mode, learn about car carrier services, car facts, road safety and colours. Mix and match the accessories to build your unique car. Be imaginative!



2. Challenge Mode

Follow the car carrier's directions to find the right pieces to build and customise a cool car. Play a memory game to finish the tasks by pressing the colour buttons in the right order.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit back **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
