

Keep this soft toy out of the sleeping environment for babies under twelve months to avoid suffocation risk.


INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover on the back of the cat's tail, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- · Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit On, slide the On/Off/
Volume Switch to the Low Volume

↑) or the High Volume ()) position.
You will hear a phrase, a song and a fun sound. To turn the unit Off , slide the On/Off/Volume Switch to the Off
position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Peek-a-Boo Paws**. will automatically shut off after approximately 45 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Heart Button

Press the **Light Up Heart** button to hear fun sounds and phrases. The cat will open and close its arms to play peek-a-boo. The lights will flash with the sounds.



2. Music Button

Press the **Music** button to hear playful melodies and songs. The lights will flash with the sounds.



3. Nature Sounds Button

Press the **Nature Sounds** button to hear relaxing nature sounds. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
- The cat is surface washable only. Do not submerge the cat in water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries. If the problem persists, please contact our Consumer Services Department and a service representative will be happy to help you.
