



Removing the Packaging Locks

- Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- (2) Pull out the packaging locks and discard.



Removing the Packaging Locks

- 1 Turn the packaging locks anticlockwise several times.
- (2) Pull out the packaging locks and discard.



WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

INSTRUCTIONS

Battery Removal and Installation-TV

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 3 new AA (AM-3/LR6)
 batteries following the diagram inside the battery box (for best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

Battery Removal and Installation-Remote Control

- Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- 2. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/ LR03)
 batteries following the diagram inside the battery box (for best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

PRODUCT FEATURES

On/Off Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/ Off Switch** to the **On** (**(b)**)position.
You will hear fun sounds, a phrase, and a song. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** (●) position.



2. Remote Control

The **Remote Control** works up to 13 feet away from the TV unit. Be sure there are no obstructions directly between the **Remote Control** and the **TV**. The **Remote Control** becomes inactive approximately 1 hour after the **TV** enters sleep mode.

3. Automatic Shut-off

To preserve battery life, the **Tune In TV** will automatically power down after approximately 40 seconds of inactivity. To reactivate the unit, press any of the three light up buttons on the TV, turn the volume dial, or use the remote control within one hour. Please note, the remote control will not function if the TV has been in sleep mode for approximately one hour.

NOTE

If the TV and remote control power down, the lights fade during play, or the short 'no power' tune is heard, we recommend replacing the batteries.

Television Activities

1. Light Up Channel Up/Down Button

Press the **Light Up Channel Up/Down Button** to change the channel, it will go to the previous/next channel of the current channel. You will hear fun sounds, friendly phrases and music. The lights will flash with the sound.







Light Up Music Button Press the Light Up Music Button to play 12 sing-along songs and 9 melodies with classic, pop and rock styles. The lights will flash with the sound.



3. Volume Control Dial
Turn the Volume Control Dial to
select the desired volume.



Remote Control Activities

1. Informational Button

Press the Informational Button to explore channels featuring the Weather, Wildlife, News, and the Art Studio. Enjoy imaginative phrases, engaging sounds, and short tunes, accompanied by flashing lights.



2. Sports Button

Press the **Sports Button** to explore channels featuring a Football Match and a Kart Race. Enjoy imaginative phrases and songs, engaging realistic football and car sounds, accompanied by flashing lights.



3. English/French Button

Press the English/French
Button to access 5 bilingual
channels in English and French.
Enjoy dynamic sounds, fun
phrases, and songs, with lights that
flash along with the sound.



4. Entertainment Button

Press the Entertainment Button to explore channels such as a Talent Show, Talk Show, Cooking, and a Film. Meet new characters and embark on exciting adventures, all accompanied by lively sound effects and flashing lights.



5. Channel Up/Down Button

Use the **Channel Up/Down Buttons** to navigate through channels, switching to the previous or next one seamlessly. Each change is accompanied by entertaining sound effects, phrases, and songs, with lights flashing in sync.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the unit is not working properly, install a brand new set of batteries.
