

Introduction

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the VTech® Swim & Splash Dolphin learning toy.

The **VTech® Swim & Splash Dolphin** is a playful bath toy that likes to spray water. Twist the starfish to activate fun sounds, phrases and music. Pour water on the dolphin or dive the dolphin under the water for fun responses and to see water spray out of its snorkel.

WARNING:

All packing materials, such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks and tags are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE:

Unlock the packaging locks:




- Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees counter-clockwise.
- Pull out the packaging locks.

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 3 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.
- 5. When closing the battery cover ensure that the screw is securely tightened. This will avoid any water leakage.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metalhydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in Battery Directive (2006/66/EC).

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF BUTTON

To turn the unit **ON**, press the **ON/OFF BUTTON**. To turn the unit **OFF**, press the **ON/OFF BUTTON** a second time.



2. WATER SENSOR

The **WATER SENSOR** is located on the top of the dolphin's head. To activate the water spraying effect, pour water on the dolphin's head, just above the mask, when the unit is first turned on.



Please note the following:

- Adult supervision is recommended when the spraying water is activated.
- Keep the speaker above the water for optimal sound quality. When the speaker is submerged in the water the sound will be muffled.
- The bottom of the dolphin must be submerged in the water to activate the motor that sprays the water.
- Do not submerge the water sensor in the water. If the water sensor is submerged, it will not work properly.

3. SPRAYING SNORKEL

The **SPRAYING SNORKEL** is located next to the light-up mask. For the spraying to work properly, the snorkel must be above the water. If the snorkel is submerged or covered, it will not spray water.



4. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the VTech® Swim & Splash Dolphin will automatically power-down after approximately one minute without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

Note: If the unit repeatedly powers down or the light flashes then fades out, we suggest changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

- 1. Press the on/off button to turn the unit on. You will hear fun sounds. a song and a phrase. The light will flash with the sounds.
- 2. Twist the starfish to hear fun phrases. sounds, songs and melodies. When a melody is playing, pour water on the dolphin's head to activate the water sensor and hear fun sounds play over the melody. The light will flash with the sounds.
- 3. When the dolphin is floating on the water, pour water on the dolphin's head to activate the water sensor and hear fun sounds and watch the water spray out of the snorkel. The light will flash with the sounds.
- 4. Dive the dolphin under the water for more than two seconds, then bring it back up to the surface of the water to hear playful phrases and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- Make sure you empty the water out of all the elements of the unit and rinse thoroughly before drying so no sediment or cleaning products are left on the unit.
- 5. Make sure to dry all the elements of the unit before storing.
- 6. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
