





# INSTRUCTIONS

#### WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

### Battery Removal and Installation – Car

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.



- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

### **IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION**

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

#### **RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES**

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

### Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.



The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.





## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

With the **VTech® Toot-Toot Drivers® Repair Centre**, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

1. Assemble and attach the base track to the track supports and repair base following the steps below:

**A.** Attach the base track A with base track B. A clicking sound will confirm they are firmly connected.




**B.** With the base track assembly upside down, insert the lift wall, base support A and base support B into the slots on the base track. A clicking sound will confirm they are firmly connected.



**C.** Attach the repair base to the base track assembly by inserting the repair base wall into the slots on the base track. Then, insert one end of the lift wall into the slot on the repair base. A clicking sound will confirm they are firmly connected.





2. Assemble the lift by attaching the lift track into the slots on the lift wall, and then slide the lift board down the lift track.





3. Insert the sign board, tyre roller, display plate, gate and ramp track into the slots on the base track.







4. Insert the car wash roller onto the car wash door, and connect the car wash door assembly to the bottom of the ramp track.



Once you've completed the above steps, you are ready to play! You can also connect the **Repair Centre play set** to other **Toot-Toot Drivers**<sup>®</sup> **play sets** (each sold separately).




# PRODUCT FEATURES

### Car

#### 1. On/Off Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On**/**Off Switch Switch** to the **On** ( $\bigcirc$ ) position. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** ( $\bullet$ ) position.



#### 2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the Car will automatically power down after approximately 60 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the light up button, pushing the Car quickly or triggering a SmartPoint<sup>™</sup> location.

**Note:** This product is in Try-Me mode in the packaging. After opening the package, turn the vehicle off and on again to proceed with normal play. If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing, please install a new set of batteries.

### ACTIVITIES Car

1. Press the Light Up Button to hear fun phrases, songs, sounds and melodies. While a melody is playing, continue pushing the Car to add fun sounds on top of the melody. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. Push the Car to hear fun sounds and phrases. The light will flash with the sounds.

3. Place the Car on one of the play set's three SmartPoint<sup>™</sup> locations to see the Car's light flash and to hear fun sounds, short tunes and phrases. The Car also interacts with other Toot-Toot Drivers® play sets (each play set sold separately).

### **ACTIVITIES Repair Centre**

- Place the Car or any SmartPoint<sup>™</sup> vehicle (each sold separately) on any of the play set's three SmartPoint<sup>™</sup> locations to hear fun sounds, music and phrases.
- Place the Car on the lift board 2. SmartPoint<sup>™</sup> to hear fun sounds and phrases. Lift the board to the top and release the Car to run down the track.









- Block the Car with the gate to hear fun sounds and phrases, lift up the gate to let the Car run down through the car wash.
- 4. Place the Car on the repair base, push and pull the joystick to move the Car and mechanical arm up and down. Move the joystick left and right to move the repair base and mechanical arm right and left.

## **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the unit is not working properly, install a brand new set of batteries.
