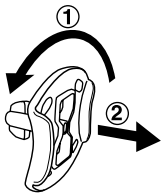

WARNING:

- ② Pull out the packaging locks.

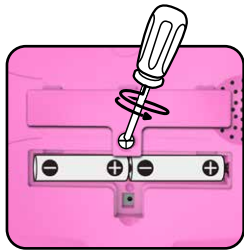
INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new 1.5V AA (LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.

- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product

The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF BUTTON

Press the **On/Off Button** to turn on the toy. To turn the toy off, press the same button again.

2. LIGHT UP BORDERS

The glowing borders illuminate in red, blue, pink, and purple during play.



3. BACKLIT SCREEN

The colour of the screen backlight can be changed from red to blue, purple or pink.



4. SLIDER

Move the **Slider** to choose among the 4 Apps.

5. 6 CHARACTER ACTIVITY BUTTONS

Press one of the **Character Activity Buttons** to choose one of the 6 learning activities.



6. 26 LETTER BUTTONS

Press the **Letter Buttons** to learn the letters, phonics, or to type words and answer questions in letter related activities.



7. 10 PIANO/NUMBER BUTTONS

Press the **Piano/Number Buttons** to discover numbers, answer questions, or to play melodies.



8. ARROW BUTTONS

Press the **Arrow Buttons** to navigate on the screen or select an option.

9. OK BUTTON

Press the **OK Button** to confirm a selection.

10. BACKLIGHT CONTROL BUTTON

Press the **Backlight Control Button** to change the background colour of the screen (red, blue, pink, or purple) or to turn off the backlight.

11. SETTINGS BUTTON

Press this button to adjust the screen contrast and volume, or turn the border lights on/off. There are 3 steps to adjust the screen contrast and 5 steps to adjust the volume level. Use the **Arrow Buttons** to adjust, and then press the **OK Button** to confirm.

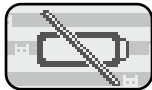
12. MUSIC ON/OFF BUTTON

Press this button to turn the background music on or off.

13. AUTOMATIC SHUT OFF

To preserve battery life, the **VTech® Gabby's Dollhouse: Categorical Tablet** will automatically turn off after several minutes of inactivity. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **On/Off Button**.

The unit will also automatically turn off when the batteries are very low. A warning will be displayed on screen as a reminder to change the batteries.



NOTE

If the unit powers down while playing, we suggest changing the batteries.

TO BEGIN PLAY

- Press the **On/Off Button** to turn the unit On. A short animation will play and you will be asked to select an activity.
- To select an activity, move the **Slider** to choose among the 4 Apps or press one of the 6 **Character Activity Buttons** to play.

APPS & ACTIVITIES

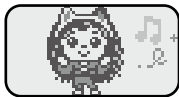
1. Letter & Number Show

Welcome to the Gabby Cat Gameshow!
Press the **Letter Buttons** to learn about letters, phonics, words and objects. Press the **Number buttons** to learn about numbers and counting.



2. Music Fun

Let's enjoy making music! Use the **Arrow Buttons** and **OK Button** to choose an instrument, and then press the **Piano/Number Buttons** to play.



Press the **Letter Buttons** to add other fun sounds and press the **Arrow Buttons** to switch to another instrument.

3. Meow Mail

Gabby is checking her messages. Help her type replies using the **Letter Buttons**. Use the **Arrow Buttons** and **OK Button** to send emojis.



4. Dollhouse Calendar

Checkout the Dollhouse calendar and see what the weather forecast is. Press the **Arrow Buttons** to flip the calendar, then press the **OK Button** to choose a day.



5. Cat Maze

Where is Gabby's cat, Floyd? Doors with matching pictures connect to one another. Press the **Arrow Buttons** to move Gabby to a door, and then press the **OK Button** to enter the door.

There are three levels. The difficulty level will change depending on your progress.



6. Tea Party Counting

It's time for a Cat-tastic tea party!

In level 1, use the **Arrow Buttons** and **OK Button** to choose the correct number of teacups.



In level 2, press the **OK button** to pour the correct number of drinks.



In level 3, add up the total number of cakes. Press the **Number Buttons** to answer.



7. Spelling Game



Let's play a spelling game. Press the **Letter Buttons** to spell the words.

There are three levels. The difficulty level will change depending on your progress.



8. DJ Class



Let's learn to play songs. Follow the falling numbers to play a song. Press the **Piano/Number Buttons** before they hit the bottom.

There are three levels. The difficulty level will change depending on your progress.



9. Bubble Popping



Bubbles, Bubbles, Bubbles! Guess which letter or number is covered by bubbles. Press the **Letter Buttons** or **Number Buttons** to answer.

There are three levels. The difficulty level will change depending on your progress.



10. Box Cats Match



Can you match the pattern with the Box Cats outfit? Press the **Arrow Buttons** to choose a pattern, and then press the **OK Button** to confirm.

There are three levels. The difficulty level will change depending on your progress.



CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
