

GETTING STARTED BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
- 2. Locate the battery cover underneath the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw. Then, remove the cover.
- If a depleted battery is present, remove it by pulling up on one end of the battery.
- Install a new AA (LR6/AM-3) battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metalhydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in Battery Directive (2006/66/EC).

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. OFF/VOLUME SWITCH

To turn the unit **ON** or to adjust the volume, slide the switch to **LOW (()**) / **HIGH (()**. To turn the unit **OFF**, slide the switch to **OFF ()**.



2. HEAD TRIGGER

Tilt the **HEAD TRIGGER** back to hear fun phrases, dinosaur facts and cool dinosaur sounds in dino mode. In vehicle mode, tilt the head to hear fun phrases and great vehicle sounds. The light projection will show with the response.




3. MOTION SENSOR

Move Turmoil to hear wild dinosaur sounds and phrases in dino mode. In vehicle mode, move Turmoil to hear great vehicle sounds.


4. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, Turmoil will automatically turn off after approximately 30 seconds without input. Turmoil can be woken up again by tilting Turmoil's head back, or by switching Turmoil between dino and vehicle modes. Turmoil will also automatically turn off when battery power is very low.


HOW TO SWITCH TURMOIL




1. Dino mode.




3. Pull the front legs up and towards the head.




5. Pull the legs towards the head as illustrated.



2. Rotate the shield 180 degrees.



4. Pull the feet backwards as illustrated.



Vehicle mode.

NOTE

To switch Turmoil back into a dinosaur, follow the above steps in reverse order.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the dino clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the dino out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the dino will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the dino on hard surfaces and do not expose the dino to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the dino OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the dino stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the dino ON. The dino should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the dino still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
