




INTRODUCTION

Note: Please cut and discard the paper ties as shown in the pictures before playing with the unit. The paper ties are not part of the product and should be discarded for your child's safety.









GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the bottom right of the unit and use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AA (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box.
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.





BATTERY NOTICE

- For those products can works properly with alkaline batteries & Ni-MH Rechargeable Batteries.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- · Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- · Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.




This product is in Try Me mode in the packaging. To activate Normal Play mode, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit ON.
- Place one of the adult characters onto the MagicPoint™.
- When you hear two short sounds, normal game play has been activated.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. Off/Low/High Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **Off/ Low/High Volume Switch** to either the Low Volume (or High Volume (to position. To turn the campervan **Off**, slide the switch to the **Off** position.



2. Mode Switch

Slide the **Mode Switch** to the right to enter Learning mode [26]. Slide the **Mode Switch** to the middle to enter Camping Fun mode . Slide the **Mode Switch** to the left to enter Night-time mode .



3. Colour Buttons

Press the four **Colour Buttons** to learn about colours, the seasons and weather.



4. Light Switch

Slide the **Light Switch** to the left to see beautiful lights shine inside the campervan. Slide the **Light Switch** to the right to see beautiful lights shine above the campervan. Turn off the unit if you feel uncomfortable.



5. Push Along

Hear songs and phrases as you roll the campervan along.



6. MagicPoint™

Place the adult characters onto the **MagicPoint™** location to hear songs and phrases.



7. Transformation

The campervan can be opened to show the interior living space, and closed again to go for a drive. Hear fun sounds when you open or close the campervan.



8. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Toot-Toot Friends™ Moonlight Campervan** will automatically shut off after several minutes of no input. The unit can be turned on again by sliding the **Off/Low/High Volume Switch** to the Low Volume position or High Volume position, or by sliding the **Mode Switch** to Learning mode, Camping Fun mode or Night-time mode position.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

Mode 1: Learning Mode

Slide the **Mode Switch** to the right position to enter this mode. Press the four **Colour Buttons** to learn about colours, the seasons and weather. Place the adult characters onto the **MagicPoint™** location to hear fun sounds.

Mode 2: Camping Fun Mode

Slide the **Mode Switch** to the middle position to enter this mode. Press the four **Colour Buttons** to hear what we can do whilst camping during the different seasons. Place the adult characters onto the **MagicPoint**TM location to hear them talk and sing.

Mode 3: Night-time Mode

Slide the **Mode Switch** to the left position to enter this mode. Press the four **Colour Buttons** to hear melodies. Place the adult characters onto the **MagicPoint**[™] to hear them hum and talk.

SING-ALONG SONG LYRICS

Song 1:

Hop on! Family road trips are really fun! Laughing and singing under the sun.

Song 2:

The world is full of things to see! From high, high mountains, to low valleys, Big, big trees and little bumblebees, How lucky are we! Yeah!

Song 3:

In the night sky, the stars are bright! We're together under the moonlight, Telling jokes and stories at our campsite.

Song 4:

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Keep the unit and its metal parts clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the toy stops working or malfunctions whilst a character is on the **MagicPoint**[™] location, please remove the character and place it back onto the **MagicPoint**[™]. If the toy still does not function, or if for some reason the toy stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
