### INTRODUCTION

Meet the **2-in-1 Push & Discover Turtle** by **VTech**<sup>®</sup>! This adorable little turtle and butterfly really are baby's best friends! The easy-tograb handle is perfect for little hands and easily detaches for two ways of play. The light up Number button, Music button and Turtle & Butterfly button introduce the turtle and butterfly, counting, sounds, melodies and phrases.

#### NOTE

#### Removing the Packaging Locks:



- Rotate the packaging lock 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- (2) Pull out the packaging lock and discard.

### **GETTING STARTED**

#### **Battery Removal and Installation**

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- 2. Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the turtle. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.



- Install 2 new AAA batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

#### WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

### **IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION**

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

### **RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:**

- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

#### Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

With the **2-in-1 Push & Discover Turtle**, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

1. Connect the **Handle Top** to the **Handle Base** as shown below. Please note that once the handle pieces are connected, they cannot be separated.



2. Attach the **Handle Base** to the turtle's body by inserting the **Handle** into the slot on the back of the turtle.



3. To remove the **Handle**, press the two buttons on either side of the **Handle Base** and pull out the handle from the back of the turtle.





### **PRODUCT FEATURES**

#### 1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/ Volume Switch** to the Low volume (■) position or the High volume (■)) position. You will hear a song and a welcoming phrase. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to the **Off** (■ position.



#### 2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **2-in-1 Push & Discover Turtle** will automatically shut off after approximately one minute without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button or turning the back wheel.

#### NOTE

If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing, please install a new set of batteries.

### ACTIVITIES

#### Number Button 1.

Press the Number Button to learn about numbers and practise counting with playful phrases and fun sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.

#### Music Button 2.

Press the Music Button to hear playful melodies and songs. The lights will flash with the sounds.

#### 3. Animal Button

Press the Animal Button to learn about the turtle and butterfly. The lights will flash with the sounds.

#### 4. Wheel Sensor

Push or pull the turtle with or without the handle attached to hear a variety of fun sounds and short tunes. Watch the turtle's head bob and the butterfly's wings flap up and down. The light will flash with the sounds.

### **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
