All packing materials, such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks and tags are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.

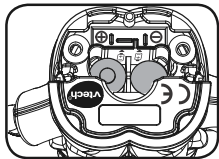
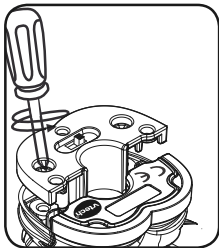

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

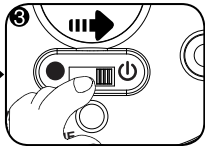
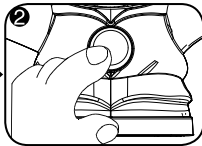
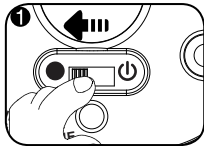
1. Make sure the unit is **OFF**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screws.
3. Install 2 new AAA size (LR03/AM-4) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screws to secure.



ACTIVATE NORMAL PLAY MODE

This product is in a try-me mode in the packaging. To activate normal play mode, please complete the following steps:

1. Slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to the **OFF** (●) position.
2. Press and hold the **LIGHT-UP BUTTON** for 2 seconds.
3. Slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to the **ON** (⬢) position to activate normal play mode.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

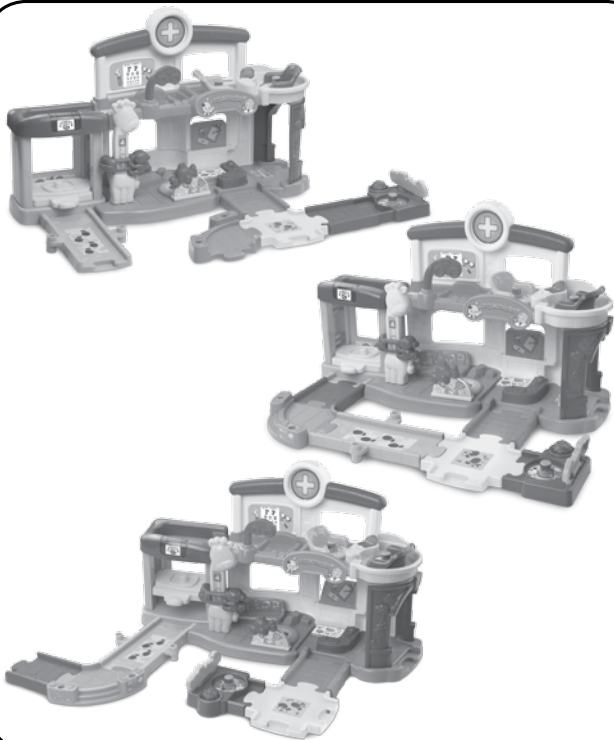
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the **VTech® Toot-Toot Friends Helpful Hospital**, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

1. Attach the pharmacy counter piece to the 1st floor wall as shown in the picture.
2. Attach the 1st floor wall, entrance archway, height measurer and scale to the 1st floor base as shown in the picture. You will hear a click sound indicating the pieces are secure.
3. Attach the 2nd floor wall to the 2nd floor base as shown in the picture. You will hear a click sound indicating the pieces are secure.
4. Attach the 2nd floor and the lift to the 1st floor as shown in the picture. You will hear a click sound indicating the pieces are secure.



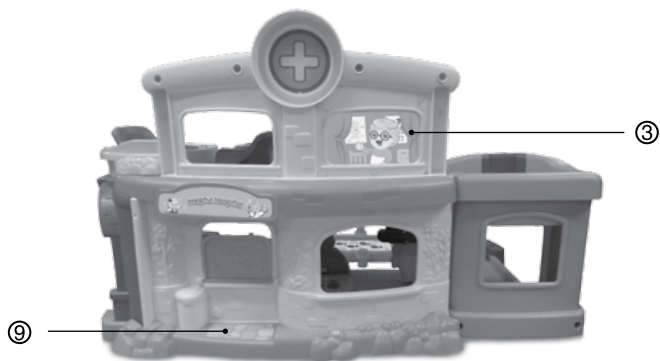
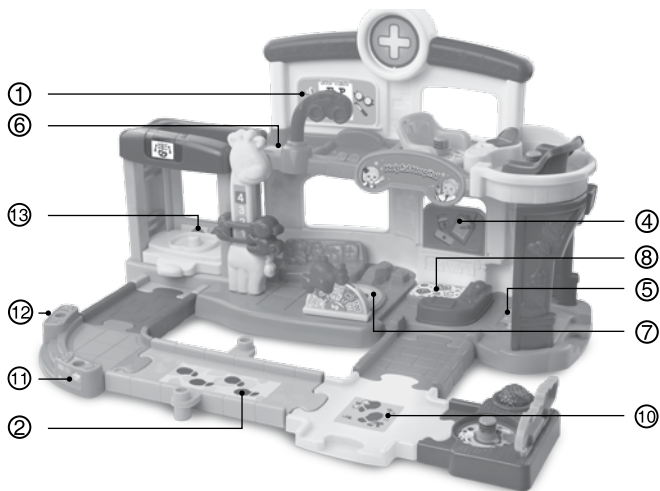
5. After the above steps, you can connect the assembled hospital and the bench to the included walkway track pieces. You can configure them into different arrangements.

Please stick the labels to the playset securely as indicated below.



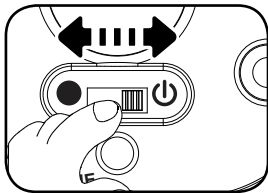


PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF SWITCH

The **ON/OFF SWITCH** is located on the bottom of the character.

To turn the unit on, slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to the **ON** (⬆) position. To turn the unit off, slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to the **OFF** (●) position.

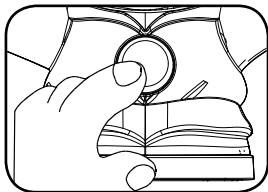


2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

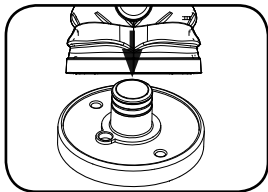
To preserve battery life, the **VTech® Toot-Toot Friends** character will automatically power down after several minutes of no input. The unit can only be turned on again by pressing the **LIGHT-UP BUTTON** or placing it on a **MagicPoint** location.

ACTIVITIES – CHARACTER

1. Slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to turn the unit **ON**. Then press the **LIGHT-UP BUTTON** to hear voices, songs, melodies and fun sounds.



2. Place the character on one of the playset's three **MagicPoint** locations to hear phrases, fun sounds, short tunes, and sing-along songs. Some of the **MagicPoint** locations can even turn on the playset's lights. The character can also interact with other **Toot-Toot Friends** playsets (each sold separately).



ACTIVITIES - HELPFUL HOSPITAL

1. Place the character on the **BENCH**'s **MagicPoint** location to help him take a rest and to turn on the bench's light.



2. Place the character on the **DOCTOR'S CHAIR** **MagicPoint** to light up the computer and to hear him talk and sing.



3. Place the character on the **PATIENT'S CHAIR** **MagicPoint** to pretend he is visiting a doctor.



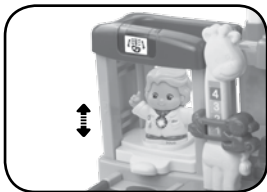
MOTOR SKILLS DEVELOPMENT - HELPFUL HOSPITAL

There are lots of fun things in the **Helpful Hospital** that you can explore to help develop fine motor skills.

1. Move the **EYE EXAM MACHINE** to help check the character's eyes.



2. Place the character on the **LIFT** and move it up and down to transfer the character to different floors of the hospital.



3. Move the **HEIGHT MEASURER SLIDER** to see how tall the character is!



4. Move the **SCALE** to check the character's weight.



5. Move the **PHARMACY COUNTER PIECE** up & down to locate the medicine.



CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit and its metal parts clean by wiping them with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to excess moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions while playing with a **MagicPoint** accessory, please remove the character from the accessory and place the character back onto the **MagicPoint**.

If the unit still does not function, or if for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions on its own, please follow these steps:

1. Please turn the unit **OFF**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
5. If the product still does not work, replace with a new set of batteries.
