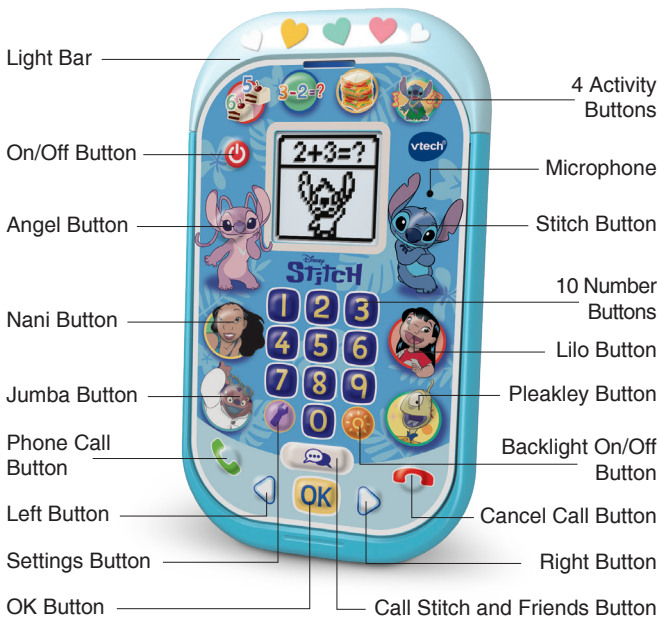

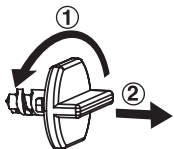
WARNING

Unlock the Packaging Locks:

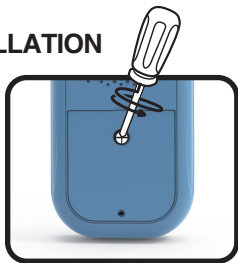


- ① Turn the packaging locks several times anticlockwise.
- ② Pull out and discard the packaging locks.

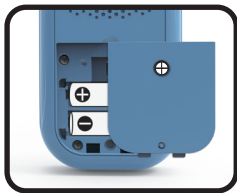
GETTING STARTED

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.



3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off Button

To turn the unit **On**, press the **On/Off Button**. Press the **On/Off Button** again to turn the unit **Off**.

2. Character Buttons

Press one of the 6 **Character Buttons** Stitch, Angel, Lilo, Nani, Pleakley and Jumba to play fun interactive mini games with them.



3. Activity Buttons

Press the **Activity Buttons** directly to play one of the 4 activities.

4. Number Buttons

Press the **Number Buttons** to learn numbers or to answer number-related questions.



5. Call Stitch and Friends Button



Press the **Call Stitch and Friends Button** to make role play phone calls and leave virtual messages for Stitch and his friends.

6. OK Button



Press the **OK Button** to confirm your choice.

7. Left/Right Buttons



Press the **Left/Right Buttons** to make a selection in activities or menus.

8. Phone Call Button



Press the **Phone Call Button** to make a virtual phone call. You will hear the phone ringing and can then pretend to leave a message on the answering machine.

9. Cancel Call Button



Press the **Cancel Call Button** at any time to exit the current activity.

10. Microphone



The **Microphone** is used for the voice activation feature. Be sure to keep the **Microphone** about 10 centimetres from your mouth for best results.



11. Settings Button



Press the **Settings Button** to turn background music **On/Off**, adjust screen contrast, or select a ringtone.

12. Backlight On/Off Button



Press the **Backlight On/Off Button** to turn the backlight **On/Off**.

13. Light Bar

The **Light Bar** will flash or light up in one of 6 colours during gameplay responses.



14. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Disney Stitch Learning Phone** will automatically turn **Off** after several minutes of inactivity. The unit can be turned **On** again by pressing the **On/Off Button**. The unit will also automatically turn **Off** when the batteries are very low. A warning will be displayed on the screen as a reminder to change the batteries.

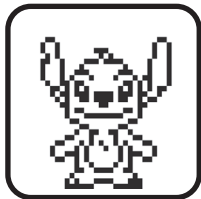
Note: This toy phone has reduced volume to adhere to safety regulations for close-to-the-ear toys.

ACTIVITIES

The **Disney Stitch Learning Phone** offers a total of 6 activities and features to play.

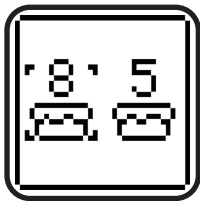
1. Playing with Stitch and his friends

Press any of the 6 **Character Buttons** Stitch, Angel, Lilo, Nani, Pleakley and Jumba to play fun interactive games with them.



2. Odd and Even Numbers

Help Stitch select the cakes with Odd or Even numbers. Press the **Left or Right Button** to choose the cakes and then press the **OK Button** to confirm.



3. Lilo's Equation

Lilo is teaching Stitch how to do sums. Help Stitch solving simple addition and subtraction equations. Press the numbers then press **OK** to confirm.



4. Making Sandwiches

Help Stitch find the fillings he wants to make sandwiches with. Press the **Left or Right Button** to choose then press **OK** to confirm.



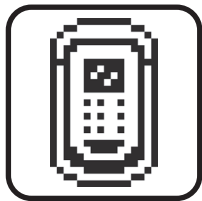
5. Stitch's Dance

Help Stitch learn to dance the Hula. Follow the numbers shown at the top of the screen and press the **Number Buttons** in order to dance.



6. Call Stitch and his Friends

Make role play phone calls and leave virtual messages for Stitch and his friends. Press the numbers to dial.



CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
