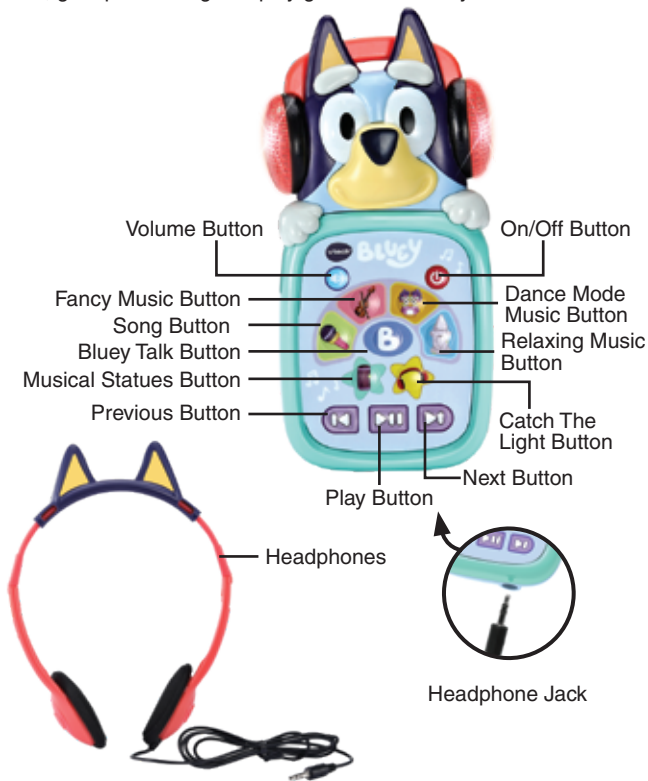

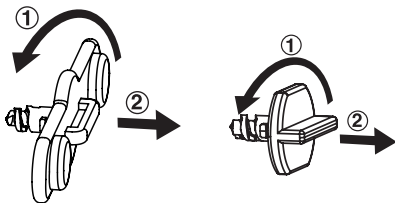
WARNING:

All packing materials such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties, cords and packaging screws are not part of this toy and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE:

Please save this Instruction Manual as it contains important information.

Unlock the Packaging Locks:



① Turn the packaging locks anticlockwise several times.

② Pull out and discard the packaging locks.

GETTING STARTED

Exit Try-Me Mode

Plug the headphones into the Bluey Music Player to exit Try-Me Mode. The player will restart.

Before playing for the first time, please install 2 new AAA batteries. (The AAA batteries included in the unit are for demo purposes only and are not life long batteries).

INSTRUCTIONS

Note:

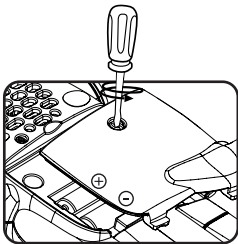
In order to protect your child's hearing, the volume level of the headphones is lower than the speaker.

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new 1.5V AAA (LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Note:

If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing or the lights fade out, we suggest changing the batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheeled bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

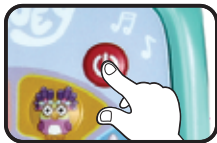

Product Features

1. ON/OFF BUTTON

Press the ON/OFF BUTTON to turn the unit ON. Press the ON/OFF BUTTON again to turn the unit OFF



2. VOLUME BUTTON

Press the VOLUME BUTTON to adjust the volume to low, medium or high.



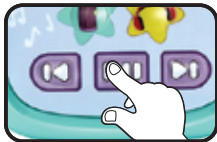
3. FUNCTION BUTTONS

A) PLAY/PAUSE BUTTON

Play or pause the music by pressing the PLAY/PAUSE BUTTON .

B) PREVIOUS BUTTON & NEXT BUTTON

Press the PREVIOUS BUTTON & NEXT BUTTON to make a selection.



4. 4 MUSIC MODE BUTTONS

Press the different MUSIC MODE BUTTONS to hear different music styles and songs.



5. BLUEY TALK BUTTON

Press the BLUEY TALK BUTTON to hear Bluey's fun phrases.



6. 2 GAME BUTTONS

Press these buttons to play games.



7. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically power-off after about 1 minute without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the ON/OFF BUTTON.

ACTIVITIES

1. Songs



Explore different Bluey and Bingo songs from the show.

2. Fancy Music



Hear classical music from the show.

3. Dance Mode Music



Dance mode! Dance along to the music.

4. Relaxing Music



Listen to relaxing music for a moment of calm.

5. Bluey Talk Mode



Hear Bluey chat about her favourite things and talk about her day.

6. Musical Statues Game



Follow Bluey's instructions and freeze when the music stops.

7. Catch The Light Game



Press the left and right arrow buttons (previous and next buttons) to catch the lights as they appear on Bluey's headphones.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
5. If the unit stops working or malfunctions, install a brand new set of batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
