INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the VTech® Splash & Swim Penguin learning toy!

The VTech® Splash & Swim Penguin is a cute bath toy for toddlers to play with during bath time. Toddlers can press the penguin's light up mask button to be rewarded with fun phrases, sounds and short tunes. They can also twist the starfish on the penguin's tummy to see the penguin splash and swim in the water! Enjoy the VTech® Splash & Swim Penguin!

WARNING: All packing materials, such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks and tags are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE: Please keep this user's manual as it contains important information.

Unlock the packaging locks:




- 1 Turn the packaging lock anticlockwise several times.
- Pull out and discard the packaging lock.

GETTING STARTED BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- 3. Install 1 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.
- 5. When closing the battery cover, please ensure that the screws are securely tightened to avoid any water leakage.

PLEASE NOTE: The speaker must be kept above water. If the speaker fills up with water, remove the penguin from the water as soon as possible and allow the water to drain away from the speaker.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metalhydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in Battery Directive (2006/66/EC).

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF BUTTON

Press the ON/OFF BUTTON for approximately a second to turn the unit ON. To turn the unit OFF, press the ON/OFF BUTTON again for approximately a second.



2. AUTOMATIC SHUT OFF

To preserve battery life, the VTech® Splash & Swim Penguin will automatically power down after approximately a minute without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the LIGHT UP BUTTON or by pressing the ON/OFF BUTTON for approximately a second.

NOTE: If the unit powers down while playing, we suggest changing the batteries.

WARNINGS:

- · The batteries must be changed by an adult.
- · This toy cannot be used in salt water.
- After using this toy, do not leave it in the water for a long time.
- Make sure to empty the water out of all elements of the toy and to rinse them out before drying.
- This toy can be operated in water only when fully assembled in accordance with the instructions.
- This is not a lifesaving device. Do not leave your child unattended while this VTech® Splash & Swim Penguin unit is in use.
- Never leave a child unattended or with an older child in the bathroom or in the bath, not even for one minute.
- Always check with a thermometer the temperature of the water coming from the tap before sitting your child in the bath. Toddlers have very sensitive skin and can easily get burnt if the water is too hot.
- When closing the battery cover ensure that the screw is securely tightened. This will avoid any water leakage.
- Only use this unit in water between 10 and 45 degrees centigrade.
- Parents should drain the water from the speaker if the volume decreases too much.


ACTIVITIES

- Press the ON/OFF BUTTON for approximately a second to turn the unit ON, you will hear a song, followed by a fun phrase and a sound. The light will flash with the sounds.
- Twist the starfish clockwise and release to make the flippers spin and watch the penguin swim.





- Press the LIGHT UP BUTTON to hear fun phrases, songs, sounds or melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.
 Press the LIGHT UP BUTTON quickly.
- 4. Press the LIGHT UP BUTTON quickly and continuously while a melody is playing to hear fun sounds play over the tune. The light will flash with the sounds.



- Pressing the LIGHT UP BUTTON quickly and continuously will play fun sound effects. Press and hold down the LIGHT UP BUTTON to hear a fun phrase.
- Press the ON/OFF BUTTON for approximately a second again to turn the unit OFF. You will hear a closing tune before the unit switches off. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Please drain all water from the unit, and ensure that the unit has been rinsed thoroughly before it is dried, so that all sediment and/ or cleaning products have been removed.
- 5. Please ensure that all elements of the unit are dry before storing it away. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, replace the batteries with an entire new set of batteries.
