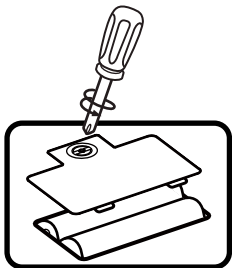

# GETTING STARTED

## Battery Removal and Installation

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Locate the battery cover on back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
3. If present, remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



## **WARNING:**

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

## **IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION**

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

## **RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:**

- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

## **Disposal of batteries and product**



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

## PRODUCT FEATURES

### 1. Off/Low/High Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **Off/Low/High Volume Switch** to the **Low Volume** (🔊) or **High Volume** (🔊🔊) position. You will hear sounds, phrases and a song. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **Off/Low/High Volume Switch** to the **Off** (●) position.



### 2. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Rainbow Cloud Piano** will automatically power down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

### NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a brand new set of batteries.

# ACTIVITIES

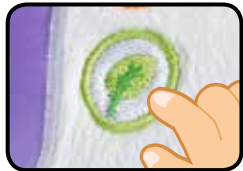
## 1. Piano Keys

Press the **Piano Keys** to hear fun sounds, phrases and short tunes. You will hear an encouraging phrase and a sound after no input for 15/30s. The light will flash with the sounds.



## 2. Nature Sound Button

Press the **Nature Sound Button** to hear nature sound effects. The light will flash with the sounds.



## 3. Music Button

Press the **Music Button** to play sing-along songs and melodies. Press the **Piano Keys** while the melody is playing and you will play one note of the song at a time. Press the **Piano Keys** during a sing-along song and you will hear fun sound effects. The light will flash with the sounds.

# CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
5. If the unit stops working or malfunctions, install a new set of batteries.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
