


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




INTRODUCTION

Hi! I'm **Bronco the Triceratops**. Use my remote control to switch me and make me race. Hit the turbo boost, and I'll take off! Let's go!

WARNING: All packing materials, such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks and tags are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.


NOTE:

- 1. Please keep the user's manual as it contains important information.
- For optimal performance, please use the remote controlled device on a flat smooth surface.
- Under the environment with electrostatic discharge and radio interference field, the sample may malfunction and need user reset to recover sometimes.

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit and remote control are turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit and remote control. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- First, install 6 new AA size (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box in the main unit. Then, install 2 new AA size (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box in the remote controller. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw in both to secure it.

NOTE: When the batteries run low, the toy will no longer respond. If this happens, please replace the batteries.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.





Please choose from one of the three label designs to decorate **Bronco the Triceratops**. Attach the chosen group of labels to the location on the product that matches the number next to the label.



Note: It is possible for the front bumper and side panel to get separated if the unit runs into something with enough force. If this happens, please reconnect the front bumper and side panel as shown below.





PRODUCT FEATURES

1. TURN THE UNIT ON

Slide the Remote Control Off/Channel Switch to the I or II position to turn the Remote Control ON.



Slide the Off/Channel Switch on Bronco the Triceratops to the same I or II position as the Remote Control. The Remote Control and Bronco the Triceratops must be on the same I or II channel to send and receive signals.



Note: I and II settings are two different channels the Remote Control and Bronco the Triceratops can operate on. If two units are operating in the same vicinity, put one unit on channel I and the other on channel II.

2. REMOTE CONTROL POWER INDICATOR

After the Remote Control is turned ON, the Remote Control Power Indicator will flash to show the remote is ON. The indicator light will illuminate anytime a button is pressed, lever is pulled or the Steering Wheel is turned. The light indicates a signal is being sent to Bronco the Triceratops.



3. SWITCH BUTTON

Press the **Switch Button** to remotely switch **Bronco the Triceratops** from dino to vehicle or from vehicle to dino.



4. TURBO CHARGE LEVER

Move the **Turbo Charge Lever** up and down to charge **Bronco the Triceratops**' turbo boosters. When Bronco is fully charged, he says, "charge complete."



5. TURBO BOOST BUTTON with LED



If Bronco the Triceratops has been charged to a level in which he has turbo boost power, the Turbo Boost Button with LED will blink. The faster the Turbo Boost Button with LED is blinking, the more time that will be allotted for the turbo boost. Once the Turbo Boost Button with LED is pressed, Bronco the Triceratops will move at an increased speed.



Note: A turbo boost will last for the duration of the charge level. If the full turbo boost hasn't been used while travelling in a certain direction, you can change direction or switch Bronco and retain the remaining turbo boost available.

6. FORWARDS/BACKWARDS

By pressing the Forwards/Backwards Button up/down, Bronco the Triceratops will move forwards/backwards.



Note: If you find Bronco the Triceratops is not moving in a straight line, you can use the Alignment Adjust to improve.



7. DIRECTIONAL STEERING WHEEL

When **Bronco the Triceratops** is moving forwards/backwards, turn the **Directional Steering Wheel** to make him turn left/right.



8. LIGHT BUTTON (🖔

Press the **Light Button** to see the two headlights illuminate and hear fun sounds and phrases.



9. TALK BUTTON (



Press the **Talk Button** to hear the dino or driver talk.



10.SOUND BUTTON



Press the **Sound Button** to hear cool sound effects.



11.STYLE BUTTON



Press the **Style Button** to change the dino eyes or choose a driver.



12. VOLUME BUTTON \leftarrow



Press the Volume Button to adjust the volume.



13.TURN THE UNIT OFF / AUTOMATIC SHUT OFF

Slide the **Off/Channel** Switch on the **Remote Controller** to **OFF** to turn it **OFF**.



Slide the Off/Channel Switch on the Bronco the Triceratops to OFF to turn it OFF.



To preserve battery life, the **Bronco the Triceratops** and the **Remote Control** will automatically power-off after several minutes without input.

Note: If Bronco the Triceratops automatically turns off, turn the unit off and slide the Off/Channel Switch back to the I or II position used prior to turn it back on.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, replace with a new set of batteries.
