




INTRODUCTION

WARNING:

Removing the packaging locks



- ① Turn the packaging lock anticlockwise several times.
- (2) Pull out the packaging lock and discard.

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the slide base. Then, use a coin or a screwdriver to loosen the screw and remove the cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03)
 batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.





BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metalhydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- · Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the **Toot-Toot Cory Carson® Freddie's Fire Station**, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

 Insert the **Top Slide** into the **Bottom Slide**. Press until you hear a "click" to indicate it is secure. Once the slides are connected, they cannot be taken apart.





Attach the Bottom Slide to the Slide Base. Press down until you hear a "click" to indicate it is secure. Once these parts are connected they cannot be taken apart.













Insert the Radar into the Top Slide. Press firmly to ensure it is connected as shown below.



 Attach the Rooftop to the Fire Station as shown below. You will hear a "click" to indicate it is secure.






5. Press the **Fire Station** into the **Fire Station Base** until you hear a "click" to indicate it is secure.












PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off Switch

To turn Freddie's Fire Station ON, slide the On/Off Switch to the ON ⊕ position. To turn Freddie's Fire Station OFF, slide the On/Off Switch to the OFF ● position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life,

Freddie's Fire Station will automatically power down after approximately 60 seconds without input. The unit can only be turned on again by pressing the Music Button, turning the Fire Hose or triggering the PlayZone Location with a mini character.

NOTE:

If the unit powers down while playing, please install a new set of batteries.



ACTIVITIES

1. PlayZone Location

Place Mini Freddie, Mini Chrissy or other Toot-Toot Cory Carson® mini characters (sold separately) on the **Playzone** to trigger sounds, short tunes and phrases.



2. Fire Hose

When a mini character is on the **PlayZone**, turn the **Fire Hose** to hear music, sounds and phrases from the show. The light will flash with the sounds. When there is no mini character, you will hear water sounds and phrases.



3. Music Button

When there is no mini character on the PlayZone, press the Music Button to hear songs, melodies and phrases. When Mini Freddie, Mini Chrissy or other Toot-Toot Cory Carson® mini characters (sold separately) are on the Playzone, press the Music Button



to hear sounds and phrases related to each character. The light will flash with the sounds



4. SmartPoint™ Location

Place a SmartPoint™ character (sold separately) on the SmartPoint™ in the Fire Station to hear fun phrases and sound effects.



CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to excess moisture.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, replace with a new set of batteries.
