

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the VTech® Crazy Legs Learning Bug learning toy.

The VTech® Crazy Legs Learning Bug is an interactive pull along toy for toddlers of 12 months and up. Six shape sorters slot into the bug's body for fun reactions and interactive phrases, teaching shapes, numbers and objects. Spinning the baby bug encourages play and the rolling design promotes crawling and walking.



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a coin or a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 2 new 'AA' (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.

- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
 - Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

Please ensure the small baby bug is locked into position before giving this toy to a child.

Assembly Instructions

- Please remove the baby bug label and the paper insert beneath it to expose the hole in the unit, and keep them out of your child's reach.
- Align the bottom of the baby bug with the hole in the unit. Push the baby bug into the hole until it clicks into place.





PRODUCT FEATURES


1. MODE SELECTOR SWITCH

To turn the unit ON, slide the MODE SELECTOR SWITCH to the Learning () or the Music () mode position. To turn the unit OFF, slide the MODE SELECTOR SWITCH to the (OFF) position.



2. PULL-ALONG CORD

To convert the unit from a push toy to a pull toy, remove the pull cord from the battery compartment and thread it through the eyelet on the bottom of the bug. For your child's safety, we suggest you store the pull cord in the compartment until your child is walking.




3. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the VTech® Crazy Legs Learning Bug will automatically power-down after approximately 45 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button. Pulling the unit or spinning the baby bug does not turn it on.

ACTIVITIES

- Press the spinning baby bug to hear talking phrases and fun sound effects in learning mode, and hear sing-along songs, talking phrases and fun sound effects in music mode. The baby bug will spin as the unit is pulled along. The lights will flash with the sounds.
- Press the shape buttons or insert the shape pieces into related shape slots to learn shapes, numbers and nature objects in learning mode, and hear sound effects and melodies in music mode. The lights will flash with the sounds.





 Press the music button to hear fun sound effects, talking phrases and questions about shapes or nature objects in learning mode, and hear melodies in music mode. The lights will flash with sounds.



4. Press the sound effect button to hear fun sound effects, talking phrases and questions about shapes or nature objects in learning mode, and hear fun sound effects and short tunes in music mode. The lights will flash with the sounds.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
