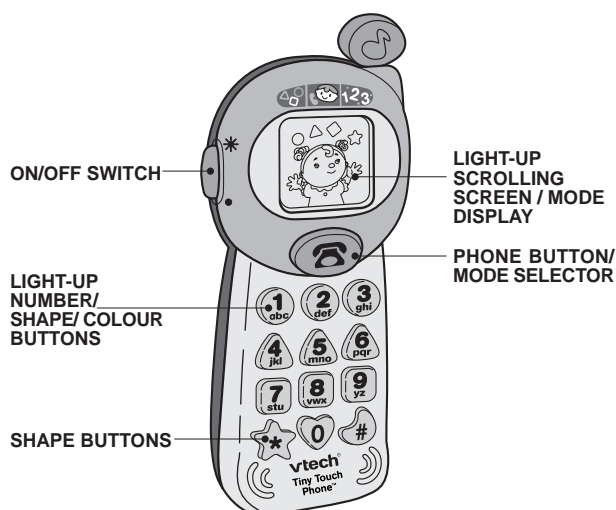


INTRODUCTION

The **VTech® Tiny Touch Phone™** is an interactive phone that's full of role-play fun! The 3 modes of play and ten bright, light-up buttons encourage little ones to explore and discover as they learn numbers, shapes and colours. With friendly phrases, fun sound effects and a cute sung song, learning has never been so exciting!

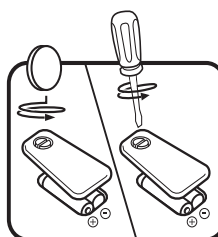

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver or coin to loosen the screw.
3. Install 2 new "AA" size (UM3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

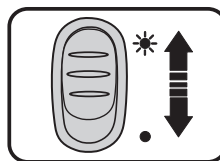
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision (if removable).
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- The toy is not to be connected to more than the recommended number of power supplies.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

WE DO NOT RECOMMEND THE USE OF RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF SWITCH

To turn the unit **ON**, slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to the **ON** (☀) position. To turn the unit off, slide the **ON/OFF SWITCH** to the **OFF** (●) position.

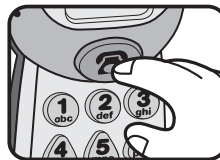


2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the **VTech® Tiny Touch Phone™** will automatically power-down after approximately 20 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

3. MODES OF PLAY

There are three modes of play - numbers, colour and shape, and role-play. Select a mode by pressing the **PHONE BUTTON** until the screen displays the mode you would like to play. You will hear a fun phrase related to the mode.



The lights will flash with the sounds.

If the **LIGHT-UP SCROLLING SCREEN** gets stuck between two modes, the buttons will give random responses only. To revert to normal play, press the **PHONE BUTTON** until a mode is selected.

ACTIVITIES

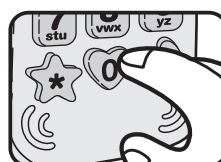
1. Press the **PHONE BUTTON** to scroll through the three screens to select a mode of play. You will hear a fun phrase related to the selected mode. The lights will flash with the sound.



2. Press the **NUMBER BUTTONS** to hear the numbers one to nine identified in number mode, colours and shapes in the colour and shape mode and a variety of phrases and music in the role-play mode. The lights will flash with the sound.



3. Press the **HEART BUTTON** to call the operator when in the number or role-play mode. In the colour and shape mode, you will hear the colour and shape of the button identified. The lights will flash with the sound.



4. Press the **STAR BUTTON** to hear random phone sounds or the colour and shape identified, depending on the selected mode. The lights will flash with the sound.



5. Press the **MOON BUTTON** to hear a song, a variety of melodies or the colour and shape identified, depending on the selected mode. The lights will flash with the sound.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit OFF.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
5. If the product still does not work, replace with a new set of batteries.

NOTE: When this product is removed from the packaging the volume will reduce to a level that complies with safety regulations for 'close-to-the-ear' toys for children under 12 Months. The volume level is set higher when in packaging to allow the product to be tried and heard over the in-store noise level.
