Getting Started

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver 2. to loosen the screw and then open the batterv cover.
- 3. If a used battery is present, remove it from the unit by pulling up on one end of the battery.
- Install 1 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batterv 4 following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).



Replace the battery cover and tighten 5. the screw to secure.

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Unlock the Packaging Locks



- Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- Pull out the packaging locks and discard. 2



- WARNING: All packing materials such as tape, plastic sheets. packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties, cords and packaging screws are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.
- Please keep this instruction manual as it contains NOTE: important information.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. .
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy. .
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product


Product Features

1. On/Off Button

To power on the character, press the **On/Off Button** (0). To power off the character, press this button again.

2. Automatic Power Off

After approximately 45 seconds of inactivity, the character will automatically power off. The character can be turned on again by pressing the **Light Up Button**.





NOTE :


If the unit powers down whilst playing, please install a new battery.

WARNING: The battery compartment must be properly closed, as per the instructions in this manual, before putting the toy in contact with water.

The toy is to be operated in water only when fully assembled in accordance with the instructions

Activities

1. Press the **On/Off Button** (也) to hear a song and to hear the character introduce themselves. The light will flash with the responses.



2. Keep pressing the **Light Up Button** to hear different phrases, sound effects, 3 songs and 15 melodies.



WARNINGS

- Batteries must be changed by an adult.
- Do not use the toy in salt water.
- We do not recommend submerging the unit in the water. If the unit does get submerged in the water, please dry the unit completely.
- To prevent drowning, never leave a child unattended in the bath.
- Use a thermometer to check the temperature of the water before sitting a child in the bath. Children have very sensitive skin and can burn easily if the water is too hot.
- The toy can only be used in water between 10°C and 45°C.
- After play, empty any water that may have accumulated (particularly in the loudspeaker) and dry the toy.
- This electronic toy is intended for use in the bath and is waterproof





when used as intended. Water cannot enter the electronic components if the battery compartment door is closed properly. Tests were carried out by immersing the toy under water to a depth of 15cm for 30 minutes. Acoustic performance is reduced when the toy is immersed in water.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Remove the unit from the water after each use.
- 2. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 3. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 4. Make sure to rinse and dry all the elements of the unit before storing.
- 5. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 6. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
