
Club VTech Jet

What You'll Need:


- ✓ Mom or Dad's help!

Using these directions, you can turn a piece of paper into a jet! To get ready, print the Club VTech Jet page onto a piece of paper and cut the paper along the dotted line to make a square sheet.


Directions:




1. Start with the blank side up. Fold the paper in half by bringing the bottom edge to meet the top edge, then fold it.




2. Fold the top left point so it touches the center crease. Repeat this step using the bottom left point.



3. You should have two diagonal edges that meet in a point on the left side of your form. Take the top diagonal edge and fold it so it lies flat against the center crease. Repeat this step with the bottom diagonal edge.




4. Now fold the top edge of your form to meet the center crease. Repeat this step with the bottom edge.



5. Turn your form over. Fold the bottom edge up to meet the top edge, and crease sharply.



6. The flaps on the front and back sides of your form will become the wings of your jet. Lift each wing up, and your Club VTech jet is ready to fly!
